SHFC launches two housing projects in Quezon City for over 1,300 families

THE Social Housing Finance Corp. (SHFC) broke ground on two multistory housing projects in Novaliches, Quezon City on April 6. The projects are part of the national Pambansang Pabahay para sa Pilipino Housing (4PH) program.



SHFC president and chief executive Federico Laxa and Quezon City 5th District Rep. Patrick Michael Vargas led the ceremonies.

Pascualer 7, a seven-story building in Barangay San Bartolome, will benefit about 300 families. Pascualer 10, in Barangay San Agustin, consists of two 14-story and one 10-story buildings to accommodate over 1,000 families.

“These projects signify our unwavering dedication to leaving no family behind, ensuring that every Filipino has access to decent and affordable housing under the 4PH, the flagship initiative of President Ferdinand Marcos Jr.,” Laxa said.
