Enforce exam law, says QC solon

Ahead of students' final and quarterly exams next month, Quezon City Representative Marvin Rillo reminded the Commission on Higher Education (CHEd) and the Department of Education (DepEd) to "vigorously enforce" the No Permit, No Exam Prohibition Law which took effect last 31 March.

"We are counting on regulators to make sure that all schools do what is required to comply with the prohibition," Rillo, one of the principal authors of the new law, said in a statement on Sunday.

Rillo made the statement ahead of the scheduled final exams of most college students next month as he expressed his expectation to the strong enforcement of 'No Permit, No Exam Prohibition Law by the two education agencies.
