A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE SINCEREST COMMENDATION AND CONGRATULATIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, HEADED BY THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, THE CITY VICE MAYOR, HONORABLE GIAN CARLO G. SOTTO, AND THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE 22ND CITY COUNCIL, TO THE 9 BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY FOR BEING AWARDED WITH THE 2023 SEAL OF GOOD LOCAL GOVERNANCE FOR BARANGAY

WHEREAS, Republic Act (R.A.) No. 11292, otherwise known as "The Seal of Good Local Governance Act of 2019," declared the State's policy to recognize the good performance of Local Government Units (LGUs) in transparency and accountability in the use of public funds, preparedness for challenges posed by disasters, sensitivity to the needs of vulnerable and marginalized sectors of society, implementation of health programs, investment and employment promotion, protection of constituency from threats to life and damage to property, and safeguarding the integrity of the environment;

WHEREAS, R.A. No. 11292 institutionalized the Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) Award, which is a recognition-based program that encourages LGUs' commitment to continuously progress and improve their performance along various governance areas;

WHEREAS, to receive the SGLG Award, LGUs must pass the assessment criteria across various governance areas, such as financial administration, disaster preparedness, social protection and sensitivity. It also includes health compliance and responsiveness, sustainable education, business friendliness and competitiveness, safety, peace and order, environmental management, tourism, heritage development, culture and arts, and youth development;

WHEREAS, the Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay (SGLGB) is a performance assessment and recognition system that aims to give distinction to barangays with remarkable performance across various governance areas. It also intends to encourage barangays to continuously progress in delivering efficient, equitable and quality public services. It puts primacy to integrity and good performance as pillars of meaningful local autonomy and development;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 2023-103 dated July 28, 2023 prescribed the general guidelines for the implementation of the 2023 SGLGB;

WHEREAS, in the year 2023, Quezon City was included among the 28 provinces, 64 cities, and 401 municipalities that received the SGLG Awards, and a total of 12 Quezon City barangays also received the SGLGB Award;

WHEREAS, Barangay Balingasa of District I, Barangay Marilag and Barangay Pansol of District III, Barangay Central, Barangay Kamuning, Barangay Obrero, Barangay Sikatuna Village and Barangay U.P. Campus of District IV, and Barangay Culiati of District VI were part of the 9 Quezon City Barangays that received the prestigious SGLGB Award;

WHEREAS, the achievements of Barangay Balingasa of District I, Barangay Marilag and Barangay Pansol of District III, Barangay Central, Barangay Kamuning, Barangay Obrero, Barangay Sikatuna Village and Barangay U.P. Campus of District IV, and Barangay Culiati of District VI, all of Quezon City, will serve as an inspiration to the City's government units and officials to take on greater challenges, to encourage outcome-based performance, to reward efforts in pursuing the general welfare of QCitizens and to properly enforce the existing laws.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to extend, as it does hereby extend, the sincerest commendation and congratulations of the Quezon City Government, headed by the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, the City Vice Mayor, Honorable Gian Carlo G. Sotto, and the Honorable Members of the 22nd City Council, to the 9 Barangays of Quezon City for being awarded with the 2023 Seal of Good Local Governance for Barangay.
