A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO REPHIL BASAK, INC., REPRESENTED BY JOED VILLASIS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A PROPOSED GASOLINE STATION WITH 1-STOREY COMMERCIAL BUILDING TO BE LOCATED AT LOT 1, BLOCK 10, REGALADO AVENUE CORNER ELGIN STREET, BARANGAY FAIRVIEW, DISTRICT V, QUEZON CITY, ALLOWING DEVIATION FROM THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED UNDER ORDINANCE NO. SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016

WHEREAS, Rephil Basak, Inc., represented by Joed Villasis, is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit for the construction and operation of a Proposed Gasoline Station with 1-Storey Commercial Building to be located at Lot 1, Block 10, Regalado Avenue corner Elgin Street, Barangay Fairview, District V, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016, the issuance of a Special Use Permit, as authorized by the City Council through a Resolution, is necessary for the construction and operation of a gasoline station;

WHEREAS, the said application for the issuance of a Special Use Permit intends to comply with the zoning classification or land use requirement of the business site as provided under the City's existing Zoning Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Sanggunian of Barangay Fairview, through its Resolution No. JAN-015-02, S-204, interposed no objection to the said proposed gasoline station and favorably endorsed the approval thereof;

WHEREAS, the applicant undertakes to comply with all the necessary and mandatory requirements prescribed by law, administrative issuances, and the existing Zoning Ordinance.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Special Use Permit to Rephil Basak, Inc., represented by Joed Villasis, for the construction and operation of a Proposed Gasoline Station with 1-Storey Commercial Building to be located at Lot 1, Block 10, Regalado Avenue corner Elgin Street, Barangay Fairview, District V, Quezon City, allowing deviation from the restrictions provided under Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.
