WHEREAS, the Quezon City Sports Development Office was created by virtue of Ordinance No. SP-2917, S-2020, entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Quezon City Sports and Recreation Management Code";

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WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government recognizes that sports development will effectively address the need for a comprehensive grassroots sports program centered on values formation inherent in the practice of sports and play;

WHEREAS, sports serve a crucial role in strengthening the youth physically, mentally, and emotionally. Engaging in sports helps young individuals develop important skills, such as teamwork, discipline, leadership, and resilience. It also promotes a healthy lifestyle and teaches valuable lessons about success and failure;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Sports Development Office is requesting for the purchase of 1 unit of motor vehicle to implement its programs and activities, with the following specifications:
