WHEREAS, Hergie Tao-Wag Bacyardan was born in the bustling city of Quezon City, particularly in Barangay Bagong Silangan;

WHEREAS, as a QCitizen, it is but fitting and proper to immensely recognize and commend Hergie Tao-Wag Bacyardan for the hard work, perseverance and excellence that prove that anything is possible.
