AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-3188, S-2023, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "2023 ORDINANCE ON THE QUEZON CITY SEAL OF GOOD HOUSEKEEPING"

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2023, the City Council passed Ordinance No. SP-3188, S-2023, otherwise known as the "2023 Ordinance on the Quezon City Seal of Good Housekeeping";

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the said Ordinance, aims to promote excellence and to recognize the initiatives of our local leaders as they practice good governance in the barangays;

WHEREAS, one of the functions of the Technical Working Group (TWG) is to identify areas of concern and if needed, recommend amendments to the Ordinance;

WHEREAS, during the post evaluation of the 2023 implementation of the Ordinance, it was discovered that the performance areas outlined in Section 4 need to be revisited;

WHEREAS, the TWG recommended amendments to the performance areas under Section 4 and inclusion of additional members under Section 8;

WHEREAS, the 22nd City Council supports the TWG's recommendation to amend Ordinance No. SP-3188, S-2023 to ensure that the needs of the QCitizens will be met continuously.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. SP-3188, S-2023 shall be amended and read as such:

"SECTION 4. PERFORMANCE AREAS. – The criteria for the awards shall be on the following performance areas:

- a. Organizational Effectiveness
- b. Financial Management
 1. Full Disclosure Policy
 2. Accounting
 3. Budget
- c. Social Protection
 1. Persons with Disability
 2. Senior Citizens
 3. Solo Parents
 4. Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC) Functionality
 5. GAD Focal Point System Functionality
- d. Disaster Preparedness
- e. Nutrition and other Health-Related Services
 1. Nutrition
 2. Non-Communicable Diseases
 3. Dengue Prevention and Control
 4. Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management Health Plan (BDRRMHP)
- f. Peace and Order and Public Safety
 1. Peace and Order (BPOC) Functionality
 2. Traffic Management
 3. Road Clearing
- g. Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Campaign

- h. *Business Friendliness and Competitiveness*
 - 1. *Ease of Doing Business*
- i. *Sanitation and Solid Waste Management*
- j. *Informal Settler Families and Housing*
- k. *Legislative Services*

SECTION 2. Section 8 of Ordinance No. SP-3188, S-2023 shall be amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 8. CREATION OF A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP. – To ensure the implementation of this Ordinance, there shall be a technical working group composed of representatives from the following offices:

- a. *Office of the City Mayor*
- b. *Office of the City Vice Mayor;*
- c. *Office of the City Administrator;*
- d. *Office of the Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod;*
- e. *Barangay and Community Relations Department;*
- f. *City Budget Department;*
- g. *City Accounting Department;*
- h. *DILG Quezon City Field Office;*
- i. *Business Permits and Licensing Department;*
- j. *Department of Sanitation and Clean-Up Works;*
- k. *Quezon City Health Department;*
- l. *Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office;*
- m. *Quezon City Anti-Drug Abuse Advisory Council;*
- n. *Department of Public Order and Safety;*
- o. *Traffic and Transport Management Department;*
- p. *Housing Community Development and Resettlement Department;*
- q. *Social Services Development Department;*
- r. *Office of Senior Citizens Affairs;*
- s. *Persons with Disability Affairs Office; and*
- t. *Gender and Development Office.*

Upon the recommendation of the TWG, the Office of the City Mayor may appoint additional members or remove member/s of the TWG members to assist in ensuring that the objectives of this Ordinance shall be achieved.”

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All other provisions of Ordinance No. SP-3188, S-2023 and all other ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, rules, regulations, and other administrative issuances contrary to the provisions herein shall be deemed amended or repealed upon the enactment of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment and publication.
