RESOLUTION NO. SP-**9793**, S-2024

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF ANYTIME GAMING EXPERIENCE TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES AND ELECTRONIC BINGO GAMES ESTABLISHMENT AT 2ND FLOOR, BUILDING A, COMMONWEALTH MARKET, COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, BARANGAY COMMONWEALTH, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, "Anytime Gaming Experience" is a domestic corporation with principal office and business address at Unit 7-A, No. 233 J. Teodoro Street, 6th Avenue, Barangay 55, Caloocan City;



WHEREAS, Anytime Gaming Experience, represented by Pablo Dela Cruz, Jr., is engaged in the business of Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo Games currently operating at 2nd Floor, Building A, Commonwealth Market, Commonwealth Avenue, Barangay Commonwealth, District II, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the said Corporation was previously granted a Special Permit by the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-2285, S-2014, as amended by Ordinance No. SP-2641, S-2017, in relation to Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991. To continue its operation, there is a need to renew the same;

WHEREAS, under the said City Ordinances and the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Council is vested with the authority to grant Special Permit for business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Anytime Gaming Experience to operate an Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo Games Establishment at 2nd Floor, Building A, Commonwealth Market, Commonwealth Avenue, Barangay Commonwealth, District II, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the renewal of this Special Permit shall be subject to the following conditions:


- a) The holding of Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
- b) It shall not include other games not related to or other than Electronic Games and Electronic Bingo Games; and
- c) Individuals who are below 21 years of age are prohibited from playing the aforementioned games.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the renewal of this Special Permit shall be valid for a period of 3 years and may be renewed again by the City Council.
