(QCPADFI) Concert Chorus has brought honor and pride to Quezon City by winning 2 gold medals in the Sacred Choral Music with Accompaniment category and the Mixed Chamber Choirs category, earning the prestigious title "Champion of the World Choir Games" at the 13th World Choir Games held last July 2024 in Auckland, New Zealand;

WHEREAS, the World Choir Games is the biggest international choir competition, providing a platform for the world's best choral singers to showcase their talent; it is considered as the largest choral festival globally, attracting more than 11,000 singers from over 30 countries;


