WHEREAS, currently, Quezon City has 41 air quality monitoring equipment and 48 water quality sampling stations to acquire the necessary data and information on ambient air and water quality for the formulation of policies and interventions to improve air and water quality in the City;

WHEREAS, in order to further improve efficiency in collecting air and water data, maintaining the various equipment deployed, and responding to immediate air and water quality concerns, there is a need to procure and assign an additional service vehicle;

WHEREAS, the abovementioned vehicle will be used by the CCESD for the above-stated purpose to attain the goals, objectives and targets stated in City plans, such as the Quezon City Enhanced Local Climate Change Action Plan 2021-2050, Air Quality Management Plan, and Water Quality Management Plan, in line with local and international commitments on air and water quality;

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455(b)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to purchase 1 unit of motor vehicle to be used by the Climate Change and Environmental Sustainability Department for improved mobility in conducting air and water quality monitoring, assessment and response in line with the projects and programs of the Quezon City Government to be charged against the available funds of the Office of the City Mayor.
