QC issues guidelines on poll paraphernalia placements

Ahead of the upcoming election campaign period, the local government of Quezon City is reminding the public and aspiring politicians to follow local ordinances regarding the posting of campaign materials.

Mayor Joy Belmonte urged everyone to respect the city's beauty and avoid cluttering public spaces with political paraphernalia. According to City Ordinance No. SP-2021 S-2010, political propaganda materials in Quezon City can only be displayed in common posting areas designated by the Commission on Elections (Comelec).

The ordinance also prohibits the posting of election materials on utility poles, traffic lights, bridges and overpasses. Each barangay in Quezon City will have a designated Comelec poster area. Additional poster areas may be approved by the Comelec for public places like plazas, markets and barangay centers.
