SP-2502, S-2016, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF 2016

WHEREAS, Powertech Industrial Sales Inc., as represented by Lim Kui Lim, a duly registered company, is applying for the issuance of a Certificate of Exception for the operation of the proposed As-Built: Two (2)-Storey Office Building and One (1)-Storey Warehouse Building with Fabrication Area located at Lots 1 and 2 PCS-00-015576, (No. 10) Leland Drive corner Maxima Drive, Barangay Balon-Bato, District VI, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 55, Article VIII, in relation to Sections 71 and 73, Article IX of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, Exceptions and Variances or Deviations from the provisions of the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016 may be allowed only upon authorization from the City Council;

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WHEREAS, the Proposed Project will not adversely affect public health, safety and welfare and is in keeping with the general pattern of development in the community;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay and the neighborhood concerned have interposed no objection to the said Project;

WHEREAS, the applicant has complied with all the necessary requirements as mandated by the said Zoning Ordinance and pertinent rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the issuance of a Certificate of Exception to Powertech Industrial Sales Inc., as represented by Lim Kui Lim, for the operation of the proposed As-Built: Two (2)-Storey Office Building and One (1)-Storey Warehouse Building with Fabrication Area located at Lots 1 and 2 PCS-00-015576, (No. 10) Leland Drive corner Maxima Drive, Barangay Balon-Bato, District VI, Quezon City, allowing Deviation from the Restrictions provided under Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2502, S-2016, otherwise known as the Quezon City Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 2016.
