A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF PHIL GRAND IMPERIAL GROUP, INC. FOR THE OPERATION OF AN ELECTRONIC GAMES (E-GAMES) ESTABLISHMENT LOCATED AT THE GROUND FLOOR, ETON CYBERPOD CORINTHIAN EDSA CORNER ORTIGAS AVENUE, BARANGAY UGONG NORTE, DISTRICT III, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

WHEREAS, Phil Grand Imperial Group, Inc. is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws, with business address at the Ground Floor, Eton Cyberpod Corinthian EDSA corner Ortigas Avenue, Barangay Ugong Norte, District III, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same Electronic Games (E-Games) Establishment through Quezon City Resolution No. SP-7472, S-2018;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City _ Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of an Electronic Games (E-Games) Establishment is regulated and licensed by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the Quezon City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Phil Grand Imperial Group, Inc. for the operation of an Electronic Games (E-Games) Establishment located at the Ground Floor, Eton Cyberpod Corinthian EDSA corner Ortigas Avenue, Barangay Ugong Norte, District III, Quezon City, subject to the Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an E-Games Establishment granted herein shall be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The holding of E-Games shall be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
- 2. The operation of the E-Games Establishment shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Games;
- 3. The operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below 21 years of age or students of any school, college or university;
- 4. Phil Grand Imperial Group, Inc. shall remit a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution, in accordance with Section 25, Article III of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended; and
- 5. This Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferrable and site-address specific.
- 6. The Establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of a Special Permit to operate an E-Games Establishment shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed by the Quezon City Council.
