~~AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE TWENTY-TWO (22) BARANGIAYS IN QUEZON CITY, ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY TYPHOON BIRING, IN A STATE OF CALAMITY AND AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE ISMAEL A. MATHAY, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO UTILIZE THE CALAMITY FUND APPROPRIATED IN THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 2000 TO COVER THE EXPENSES FOR THE RELIEF ASSISTANCE EXTENDED TO THE TYPHOON VICTIMS ON MAY 18, 2000 IN QUEZON CITY.~~

WHEREAS, Sec. 3 (a) of the Rules and Regulations Implementing RA. 8185, defines calamity as "a state of extreme distress or misfortune produced by some adverse circumstances or events or any great misfortune or cause or loss or misery caused by natural forces such as earthquake, typhoons, floods, hurricanes, epidemics or other disaster causing widespread loss of and/or extreme damage to human lives, livestock, crops and properties;

WHEREAS, typhoon Biring occurred on May 18, 2000 with continuous heavy rains all day long, thus, causing flashflood in several barangays in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, based on the report submitted by the Social Services Development Department twenty-six barangays were adversely affected by said typhoon and heavy rains, thus, need for evacuation centers to cater the evacuees or victims amounting to Four Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty One (P4,781 00) families, more or less;

WHEREAS, the said victims are being taking cared of by the city government by providing them with food, medicines and other relief goods,

WHEREAS, there is a need to authorize the City Mayor to release the calamity funds necessary,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED :


SECTION 1. The following Barangays are hereby declared in a state of calamity,

SECTION 2. The Honorable Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., is hereby authorize to utilize the calamity fund to be used in taking emergency measures for the relief assistance to the victims of typhoon Brang that occurred on May 16, 2000 in Quezon City.

SECTION 3. That the funds to be released will be directly and exclusively used to cover the emergency purchases undertaken by the Social Service Development Department (SSDD) during the period of Calamity in the amount of Nine Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Five Pesos (P939,765.00).
