ONDINANCENTO. 937 15-2000

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THAT TRUCKS AND OTHER MEANS OF TRADESPORT WITH CEMENT MIXERS OR OTHERWISE LOADED WITH WET CEMENT SHOULD PROVIDE FOR A MEANS TO PREVENT CEMENT DRIPPINGS FROM FALLING ON THE ROADS AND STREETS OF QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WITHREAS, it has been observed that trucks and other means of transport with coment mixers or otherwise loaded with wet coment traverse Quezoa City unmindful of the coment drippings that fall on the city street and roads;

WHEREAS, coment drippings of any nize, when left unattended, harden into unsightly lumps on Quezon City's streets and roads omising damage and inconvenience to other vehicles and in effect damaging the city's thoroughfures;

WHEREAS, this can be easily prevented by making sure that said vehicles provide for a system or means by which coment drippings do not fall on the city's streets.

## NOW, THEREPORE,

HE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION i. Henceforth, it shall be unlawful for trusks and other vehicles bearing loaded coment mixers or etherwise loaded with wet coment without a system or means of preventing wet coment drippings from falling on Quezon City's streets and reads to traverse the roads, streets, alleys and other thoroughfares of Quezon City.

SECTION 2. Every violation of this Ordinance shall be punished with a fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00)

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
