AN ORDINANCE CONVERTING DON ALEJANDRO ROCES, SR., VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL INTO DON ALEJANDRO ROCES, SR. SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Don Alejandro Roces, Sr. Vocational High School, thru its Principal, has requested that the school be converted into Don Alejandro Roces, Sr. Science and Technology High School;

WHEREAS, establishing a Science and Technology School in Quezon City is in line with the city's goal of producing globally competitive, self-reliant and productive citizens who can contribute to the socio-economic well-being of the community;

WHEREAS, while the Regional Science Schools, Learning Resource Centers and Science and Technology Oriented Schools cater to intellectually gifted students, are focused on knowledge of pure sciences, and aim to prepare students for a career in the sciences, a Science and Technology School will cater to the average group who may or may not proceed to college;

WHEREAS, Don Alejandro Roces, Sr. Science and Technology High School will implement a special curriculum that will provide appropriate background in science and technology to students to enable them to apply knowledge, skills and attitude learned in school into businesses and industries, consequently preparing them for the world of work;

WHEREAS, Don Alejandro Roces, Sr. Vocational High School has been offering during the school year 1999-2000 a science and technology enriched curriculum with the approval of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports to three (3) sections of the one hundred forty five (145) first year students;

WHEREAS, the students of the pilot science and technology classes were already given orientation in all the subjects including technical curricular offerings;

WHEREAS, these students have taken an aptitude test to determine their line of specialization or their choice from the following technical courses: Civil Technology, Automotive Technology, Business Communication, Electronics Technology, Garment Trades, and Food Trades, under which they will undergo specific but individualized training programs from first year up to fourth year;

WHEREAS, the following rooms and facilities are now being used by the pilot classes;

Three (3) rooms for academic subjects with new and complete arm chairs, teacher's table and blackboard;

One (1) laboratory room with instructional materials and other equipment of the Science Department;

Six (6) shop rooms which are continuously being improved to become better, safer and more conducive workplace for students;

One (1) computer laboratory room; and,

School library with enough references;

WHEREAS, the conversion of Don Alejandro Roces, Sr. Vocational High School into a Science and Technology School is a fitting acknowledgement of the school's commitment to:

- Primarily serve as an educational institution for continuing quality science and technology education and training;
- Promote studies and progressive leadership in science and technology education and other fields as may be relevant, and encourage and undertake research and contribute to the dissemination and application of knowledge in science and technology; and,
- Offer quality education at a reasonable and affordable cost for the financially disadvantaged but talented, qualified and deserving youth of Quezon City and of the country.
