

ORDINANCE NO. SP- 941 - 2000

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF AMBULANT/PUSH CART JUNK DEALERS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Introduced by Councilors ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE and JORGE L. BANAL.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Vincent P. Crisologo, Marciano P. Medalla, Eric Z. Medina, Ramon G. Mathay and Bayani V. Hipol.

WHEREAS, there are numerous ambulant/push cart junk dealers plying their trade or business in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there are reports that some unscrupulous elements have been using the said ambulant/push cart junk dealers as a means to roam around the streets of Quezon City from dusk till dawn and effect robberies, thefts and other crimes against households and business establishments;

WHEREAS, it is neither desirable nor necessary for these ambulant/push cart dealers to ply their trade or business from dusk till dawn considering that they pose as possible traffic hazards and households and business establishment normally do not deal with them during the said hours;

WHEREAS, it is desirable for push carts used for the junk trade or business to be monitored through a system of accreditation/registration involving the barangay where the business establishment of the capitalist junk dealer is located;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Push carts and ambulant/push cart junk dealers shall be accredited/registered by the capitalist junk dealer with the barangay where the latter's business establishment is located. As proof of such registration, the ambulant/push cart junk dealer shall be issued an identification card by the barangay concerned and the push cart itself shall sport a body number, to be determined by the barangay concerned, and the name of the barangay where the business establishment of the capitalist junk dealer is located.

SECTION 2. Ambulant/push cart junk dealers shall be allowed to ply their trade or business only from six o'clock in the morning to six o'clock in the evening.



SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for capitalist junk dealers not to have their push carts and their ambulant/push cart dealers accredited/registered with the barangay where the former's business establishment is located.

SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for push cart junk dealers, while plying their trade or business, to use a push cart not accredited/registered with and display the identification card issued them by the barangay where the business establishment of the capitalise junk dealer is located.


SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for ambulant/push cart junk dealers not accredited or registered as provided in Section 4 hereof, to ply their trade or business at any time within the City

SECTION 6. The Business Permits and Licensing Office of the Quezon City government is hereby authorized to issue guidelines for the implementation of this Ordinance

SECTION 7. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be penalized with a fine of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) for every count.


SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
