ORDINANCE NO. SP- 9 5 4 7, S-2000

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A WOMEN'S CENTER AT LA LOMA HEALTH CENTER, CUBAO HEALTH CENTER AND NOVALICHES HEALTH CENTER UNDER THE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

Introduced by Councilor WILMA AMORANTO-SARINO.

WHEREAS, there is an established risk of sexually transmitted diseases to women of reproductive age as well as identified commercial sex workers (CSW's) in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, reproductive health is a specific approach of the City Health Department to answer the increasing problems of women on reproductive tract infections;

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish centers to implement a comprehensive, preventive and curative Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) Program for such clients;

WHEREAS, necessary information must be accorded to all affected women for their awareness that there is such a center to cure them of their afflictions;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There shall be established a Women's Center at La Loma, Cubao and Novaliches Health Centers which shall implement the Comprehensive Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Program.


SECTION 2. The City government through the City Health Department shall provide the health personnel, medical equipment, supplies and medicines.


SECTION 3. The funds for the purpose shall be taken from any available funds of the City Health Department.
