AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THAT PORTION OF SCOUT ALBANO STREET FROM THE CORNER OF MOTHER IGNACIA STREET UP TO EPIFANIO DE LOS SANTOS AVENUE (EDSA) AS EUGENIO LOPEZ STREET.

WHEREAS, business tycoon Eugenio Lopez led his family in dedicating all their enterprises to the service of the Filipino subscribing as he did to the philosophy of "rendering public service in the conduct of business;

WHEREAS, Eugenio Lopez and his family suffered financial ruin as their businesses were taken away from them by the former dictatorship;

WHEREAS, Eugenio Lopez was a pillar of the struggle to oust the Marcos dictatorship, himself suffering from incarceration and eventually gaining freedom though a daring escape out of the dictator's prison;

WHEREAS, Eugenio Lopez painstakingly led his family in slowly rebuilding their businesses after the ouster of the dictatorship, steadily gaining lost ground until their companies finally reclaimed the dominant place they currently hold in Philippine business;

WHEREAS, Eugenio Lopez anchored the drive of the Lopez family to venture into other areas where they could be of more service to the Filipino – thus engaging in water distribution, telecommunication, toll roads, land development and power generation and distribution.

WHEREAS, Eugenio Lopez, in his own personal way, showed his deep concern for the poor and underprivileged of society by actively participating in several philanthropic efforts;

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED.

SECTION 1. The portion of Scout Albano Street from the corner of Mother Ignacia Street up to Epifanio de los Santos Avenue (EDSA) located in Barangay South Triangle, District IV, Quezon City is hereby renamed EUGENIO LOPEZ STREET

SECTION 2. To avoid confusion and any inconvenience that may arise in the delivery of postal matters and in guiding people accustomed to the old name, the signage of the new street name shall include "SCOUT ALBANO STREET' to be printed at the bottom of the signage "EUGENIO LOPEZ STREET."

SECTION 3. The Secretary of the City Council shall furnish a copy of this Ordinance to the Office of the President, both Houses of Congress, the National Statistics Office, Philippine Postal Corporation, National Historical Institute and other concerned agencies for their information and appropriate action.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
