

ORDINANCE NO. 8633 - S-71

ORDINANCE

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 7613, S-68 PROHIBITING THE CLOSING, OBSTRUCTING, PREVENTING OR OTHERWISE REFUSING TO THE PUBLIC OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, THE USE OF OR FREE ACCESS TO ANY SUBDIVISION OR COMMUNITY STREET WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY, SO AS TO INCLUDE IN SUCH PROHIBITION THE EXACTION OF FEES IN ANY FORM FOR THE USE THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City
in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Section One of Ordinance No. 7613,
S-68, is hereby amended to read as follows:


"SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to close, obstruct, prevent, or otherwise refuse to the public or vehicular traffic the use of or free access to any subdivision or community street within the jurisdiction of Quezon City, or to exact fees in any form for the use thereof."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
