



ORDINANCE NO. SP-1097S-2002

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6 (C) OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-15, S-92 AS FURTHER AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP-195, S-94, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY TRICYCLE ORDINANCE OF 1992.

WHEREAS, certain requirements were deleted in the application for renewal of tricycle franchise, under SP-195, S-94 specifically the matter on the compulsory coverage of insurance policy for applicants;

WHEREAS, considering the importance of said provision in order to protect the riding public in indemnifying their passengers or third parties in case of accident, the same should be imposed mandatory;

WHEREAS, it is of public knowledge of the proliferation of insurance companies, whose existence is dubious thus it is imperative that the insurer should be known of good reputation in the insurance business.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 6 (c) of Ordinance No. SP-15, S-92 as amended by Ordinance No. SP-195, S-94 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- " Section 1. x x x
- a) Section 5- x x x
- b) Section 6 (c)

All applicants for a Tricycle Franchise should present the following documents:

1. Document(s) attesting to the applicant's citizenship;
2. Certificate of Barangay Captain

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
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
- i. That the applicant is a bonafide resident of the barangay within the City/Municipality, or:
 - ii. That the unit applied for is actually operating in the City/Municipality
3. Land Transportation Office Certificate of Registration (CR) and Official Receipt of Registration (OR) for the current year applied for and issued in the name of the applicant.
 4. Insurance policy to cover any liability it may incur to passengers and third parties in case of accident upon the filing of the petition for new franchise or renewal of an insurance company in good standing duly accredited by the Insurance Commission."

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




