**ORDINANCE NO. SP 1162, S-2002**

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING COMMON PROVISIONS RELATIVE TO ORDINANCES NUMBERED SP-751, S-98; SP-750, S-98; SP-748, S-98; AND SP-749, S-98, ARRANGING THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS GRANTED THEREUNDER AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

COSETENG, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. JANET M. MALAYA, RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO and RESTITUTO B. MALANGEN.

WHEREAS, Ordinances Numbered SP-751, S-98; SP-750, S-98; SP-748, S-98; and SP-749, S-98, granted to All Point Leisure Corporation, Manila Bingo Corporation, Bingo Bonanza Corporation and Galleria Bingo Corporation, respectively, special permits to establish Bingo Halls at SM Center Point, SM Fairview Mall, New Farmers Plaza, SM City-North Edsa and Robinson's Galleria, or the purpose of holding bingo games, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR);

WHEREAS, the bingo operators mentioned in the first Whereas Clause hereof have been authorized by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) to operate Bingo

Halls where bingo games may be played;

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City has the authority to grant franchise through the enactment of Ordinances authorizing the issuance of permits and licenses, including permits to carry on the conduct of all kinds and phases of operations;

WHEREAS, it is, likewise, provided under Republic Act No. 7160, in Section 192 thereof, that "local government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary."

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is hereby declared the policy of the local government of Quezon City to enact, develop and implement measures designed to promote the general welfare of its constituents. Hence, protection shall be accorded to the maintenance of peace and order and the promotion of the health, safety, morals and the general welfare, including such regulations as may be necessary, sufficient and effective to achieve this declared policy.

SECTION 2. EFFECT OF THE AMENDING ORDINANCE - Ordinances Numbered SP-751, S-98; SP-750, S-98; SP-748, S-98; and SP-749, S-98, shall be deemed to have amended and superceded Ordinances Numbered SP-517, S-97; SP-541, S-97 and SP-537, S-97, respectively, from the moment of the effectivity of the amendatory ordinances. The amended ordinances shall have force and effect only until such dates of effectivity.

SECTION 3. GRANT OF SPECIAL PERMIT - The grant of special permits to All Points Leisure Corporation, Manila Bingo Corporation, Bingo Bonanza Corporation and Galleria Bingo Corporation, is hereby affirmed, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR). They may conduct any and all kinds and phases of bingo operations at their duly designated places of establishment, including the conduct of electronic bingo, excepts as otherwise provided by law, ordinance, rules and regulations.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - Should any part of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional for whatever reason by a competent court, the portions hereof not affected by the declaration shall remain effective and enforceable.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect after fifteen days following the completion of its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
