ORDINANCE NO. SP-1172, S-2002

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN ALL CONVENIENCE STORES LOCATED WITHIN THE PREMISES OF ALL GASOLINE STATIONS IN QUEZON CITY, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, a number of convenience stores operating within the premises of gasoline stations are known to sell and, at some instances, may have allowed the consumption of alcoholic beverages inside said premises.

WHEREAS, motorists who frequent these gasoline stations may be encouraged to buy and consume alcoholic beverages while within the compound of these stations;

WHEREAS, this particular circumstance may put to risk motorists driving under the influence of liquor, endangering not only themselves, but the public, as well;

WHEREAS, the local Government Code empowers the Sangguniang Panglungsod to enact ordinances to prevent, suppress and impose appropriate penalties for habitual drunkenness in public places and to regulate activities relative to the use of land, buildings, and structures within the City in order to promote the general welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any operator/proprietor of a convenience store located within the premises of a gasoline station operating within Quezon City to allow the consumption of alcoholic beverages within such gasoline station.

SECTION 2. Alcoholic beverages include, but are not limited to, the following: beer, wine, mixed cocktails with alcohol content and other derivatives thereof that can intoxicate persons.

SECTION 3. The penalty of a fine shall be imposed for violation of the following acts:


- a.) for persons who drink/consume alcoholic beverages within the premises of gasoline stations P1,000.00
- b.) for operator/proprietor of the convenience store 3,000.00 1st Offense


SECTION 4. All other ordinances, rules and regulations found to be contrary to or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 5. If any part or provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions thereof not affected thereby shall remain in full legal force and effect.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
