# ORDINANCE NO. SP-11982002

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING HOSPITALIZATION PRIVILEGES TO ALL QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES, AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (Php10,000,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE 2003 EXECUTIVE BUDGET OF THE NON-OFFICE FUND OF THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

WHEREAS, one of the primary concerns of the Quezon City Government is to protect and care for the health and well-being of its officials and employees;

WHEREAS, Quezon City General Hospital, Noveliches District Hospital and the Sta. Lucia Armex Hospital are Quezon City government-owned hospitals which must be fully utilized to achieve the above purpose;

WHEREAS, the City Government workers should be given incentives in order that they will avail themselves of the services of these hospitals.

### NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All officials and employees of the Quezon City Government are hereby granted hospitalization privileges at the Quezon City General Hospital, Novaliches District Hospital and the Sta. Lucia Ameri Hospital, provided that they should not be required to pay any hospital or medical fees and charges.

The privileges herein granted shall likewise cover the direct dependents of its Quezon City government workers. As used in this Ordinance, direct dependents that he limited only to the perents and children of the employees.

SECTION 2. The amount of Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00) is hereby propriated in the 2003 Executive Budget and every year thereafter, under the Non-Office Fund of the Office of the City Mayor for the purchase of medical applies and medical consultancy fees.

SECTION 3. A committee composed of the City Mayor, the City Council Chirperson of the Health Committee or their respective representatives and the Director of the Quezon City General Hospital is hereby created and anthonized to issee the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The privileges granted under Section 1 hereof shall be tonsidered as exception to the pertinent provisions of the 1993 Quezon City Revenue Code.

SECTION 5. Any other ordinances which are in conflict with this Ordinance meterby smended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
