



ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1201, S-2002

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BENEFITS AND EMOLUMENTS TO ALL SANGGUNIANG KABATAANG KAGAWADS OF QUEZON CITY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 77 (5) (b-4) OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991.

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article 2 of the 1987 Constitution provides that, "the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs,"

WHEREAS, Article 77 (5) (b-4) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates that, "The Sangguniang Kabataan Officials shall have the same privileges enjoyed by other Sangguniang Barangay Officials under the Code, subject to such requirements and limitations provided in these Rules. xxx,"

WHEREAS, all duly elected kagawad of the Sangguniang Kabataan have been deprived of their emoluments/allowances and other non-monetary benefits contrary to the provisions of the Local Government Code and its implementing rules as above-cited;

WHEREAS, these emoluments/benefits and other non-monetary benefits will serve as incentive to the valuable services and contributions rendered or to be rendered by these elected youth officials in the pursuit of excellence for the youth of their barangay and the community in general;

WHEREAS, in recognition of their vital role in the barangay and the community, it is necessary that they receive these benefits due their positions.

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:**

**SECTION 1. Title.** - This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Granting Benefits and Emoluments to All Elected Sangguniang Kabataan Kagawad (SK Kagawad) of Quezon City".

**SECTION 2. Monthly Allowance.** - All SK Kagawads of Quezon City, shall each receive a monthly allowance amounting to One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00), which shall be divided and paid equally on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of every month beginning Calendar Year 2003.

**SECTION 3. Other Benefits and Privileges.** - The Sangguniang Kabataan Kagawad of Quezon City shall be entitled to the benefits and privileges received by the Sangguniang Barangay Officials, as follows:

- a) Christmas bonus of at least One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00);
- b) Insurance coverage during their incumbency which shall include, but not limited to, temporary and permanent disability, double indemnity, accident insurance, death and burial benefits;
- c) Free medical care including subsistence, medicines and medical attendance in government hospitals and institutions;
- d) Be exempted during their incumbency from the payment of tuition fees in all state colleges and universities within the city;
- e) Be entitled to appropriate civil service eligibility on the basis of the number of years of service to the Barangay.

**SECTION 4. Barangay Action.** - The fund shall be allocated through a Barangay Resolution duly passed and approved by the Barangay Council concerned and shall be reflected in the Barangay Budget submitted to the City Council during the budget hearing for Calendar Year 2003.

**SECTION 5. Inclusion in Barangay Budget.** - In the preparation of the Annual Barangay Budget beginning calendar year 2003 and succeeding years, the Barangay Treasurer of each Barangay of the city shall include therein the compensation and emoluments to be received by their respective SK Kagawads.


**SECTION 6. Certification.** - In the availing by the Sangguniang Kabataan of the privileges mentioned under Section 3 (c), (d) and (e) hereof, the Barangay shall issue a certification that the former is entitled to receive such benefits pursuant to the IRR of RA 7160. ~~45~~

**SECTION 7. Copy to the DILG. - The City Council Secretary is hereby directed to furnish the Secretary of the Department of Interior and Local Government a copy of this ordinance.**

**SECTION 8. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.**
