

ORDINANCE NO. SP-1203, S-2002

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING INCENTIVES TO BARANGAYS PRACTICING BEST SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, Section 17 (b)(1)(iii) of RA No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that all barangays shall provide basic services and facilities devolved to them which include among others, general hygiene and sanitation, beautification and solid waste collection;

WHEREAS, in Section 2 Article 1 (d) of RA No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to adopt a systematic comprehensive and ecological solid waste management program which shall "ensure the proper segregation, collection, transport, storage, treatment and disposal of solid wastes through the formulation and adoption of the best environmental practices in ecological waste management, excluding incineration";

WHEREAS, best environmental practices in solid waste management at the barangay level are widely encouraged and recognized by the Quezon City Government;

WHEREAS, outstanding initiatives and remarkable accomplishments of the barangays in solid waste management contributes significantly to City Government's over-all efforts in the management of solid wastes considering that said efforts may eventually result to reduction in the garbage hauling costs;

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WHEREAS, to uplift the enthusiasm of the barangays and encourage active participation in any program geared towards the promotion of an effective and best solid waste management practice, the granting of incentive package is hereby provided under Section 45 (b), Chapter IV of RA 9003.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known and cited as "Best Solid Waste Management Incentives in Barangays."

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following term shall mean:

a) Incentive package refers to the incentive scheme in the form of financial assistance that the City Government has formulated to be granted to barangays practicing best solid waste management.

b) Best Solid Waste Management is the solid waste management system that the barangays have adopted and are currently practicing in consonance with existing environmental laws such as RA 9003 and other related laws.


SECTION 3. COVERAGE. - This incentive package applies to all barangays that meet all the criteria set forth in this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. CRITERIA FOR AVAILMENT. - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following are the Criteria for Availment:

a) A "Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan" must be prepared by the barangay and duly approved by the City through the Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department (EPWMD).

b) The barangay should have been practicing best solid waste management for at least six (6) months and must have achieved at least twenty-five percent (25%) volume reduction of its solid wastes.

c) The barangay has an ecological or recycling center or Materials Recovery Facility (MRF).

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SECTION 5. BASIS IN THE COMPUTATION OF INCENTIVE PACKAGE. - The basis for the computation is the study of the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) conducted in 1997-1998 preparatory to the formulation of the Master Plan Metro Manila Solid Waste Management:

- a) Population
- b) Factors
 - 1. Waste Generation/capita/day = 0.585 kg. (based on JICA study)
 - 2. Assumed Density = 200 kg./cu.m.
- c) Garbage Collection Truck Capacity
 - 1. 10 - wheeler = 16 cu.m.
 - 2. 6 - wheeler = 10 cu.m.
 - 3. Mini-DT/Compactor = 8 cu.m.
- d) Actual Garbage Truck
 - 1. number of cell/route/zone
 - 2. Collection day
 - 3. Frequency of Collection
 - 4. No. of trips/day
- e) Garbage Collection Cost
 - 1. Truck type/capacity
 - 2. Approved hauling rate based on district

SECTION 6. PERCENTAGES OF THE INCENTIVE PACKAGE. - The barangay shall receive an incentive package equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the savings they have made based on computation of the EPWMD.

SECTION 7. COMPUTATION OF THE INCENTIVE PACKAGE. - Based on the population, the solid waste generated by the barangay is computed and the truck requirement to collect all the solid wastes generated is determined. After determining the number of truck required, the same is compared to the actual number of trucks being utilized to collect the barangay's solid wastes. The difference represents the savings in garbage hauling costs. The formula to be used for the purpose of this Ordinance is as follows:

FORMULA:

$GCS = ETR - AGT$

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Where:

- GCS = garbage collection savings
- ETR = estimated truck requirement based on population
- AGT = actual number of trucks needed to collect garbage

Thus:

INCENTIVE PACKAGE = 50% (GCS x AMOUNT)

SECTION 8. CONDITIONS OF THE INCENTIVE PACKAGE SCHEME -

For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following are the Conditions of the Incentive Package Scheme:

- a) The "Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan" shall be reviewed every 10th month of the year and shall be submitted to the City through the Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department (EPWMD).
- b) The barangay's Monthly Accomplishment and Status Report shall be submitted to the EPWMD.
- c) The City, thru the EPWMD, may impose other conditions in compliance to new policies, laws, and regulations, among others.

SECTION 9. PAYMENT. - For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following

are the ways of payment:

- a) The awarding of the incentives to the Barangays shall be made on a monthly basis during the enforcement of the incentive package.
- b) The disbursement of the incentives shall follow the budgeting, accounting, and auditing procedures of the government.

SECTION 10. SOURCE OF THE INCENTIVE PACKAGE..- The

allocation for the incentive package shall be taken from available funds of the City.





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
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SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




