ORDINANCE NO. SP-1204S,2002

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BARANGAY LENGTH OF SERVICE BENEFITS/INCENTIVES TO ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS AFTER THEIR TENURE OF OFFICE.

WHEREAS, barangay officials are the frontliners in government service as the barangay serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, projects, programs and activities of the national and city government;

WHEREAS, after their tenure, barangay officials are left abandoned by the government although they are entitled to an equivalent civil service eligibility very few of them invoke their preference in government service as provided for in the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, granting them incentives on the basis of their length of service will boost their morale after their tenure and such financial incentives could somehow help them, taking into account the economic and social status of barangay officials.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Elected officials after their tenure of office shall be entitled to a financial incentive of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per year of service

SECTION 2. Barangay officials who served in an appointment status or capacity to fill up an elective position such also be entitled to the herein incentives Provided, however, that they should have served for at least one (1) year.

SECTION 3. The provisions of Sections 1 and 2 shall not apply in case where the said barangay officials have been elected for three (3) consecutive terms. In which event they will be entitled to receive a plaque of recognition in an appropriate ceremony as well as financial incentive assistance as follows;


- a. For Punong Barangay P30,000.00
- b. For Barangay Kagawad P20,000.00


SECTION 4. The availment of the benefit shall be after their tenure of office and upon submission of the requirements needed such as certification from the Barangay Operations Center, clearance from the Barangay where he served, and other requirements which the City Treasurer may require.

SECTION 5. The sum of Five Million Pesos (P5,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated and set aside for the purpose, funds of which will be taken from any available funds of the city government.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


