ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1232, s-2003

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THAT ALL STREET SIGNS LOCATED IN QUEZON CITY BE MADE UNIFORM WITH DISTRICT II BEING THE PILOT AREA, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, basic in all road networks is the provision of adequate, comprehensible and distinct street signs;

WHEREAS, over the years, normal wear and tear has caused the destruction and absence of street signs in Quezon City, particularly in District II;

WHEREAS, the present condition of street signs in District II has caused confusion to residents, motorists, and the general public;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod as the local legislative body of the city, is empowered to approve ordinances and resolutions which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities to the public;

WHEREAS, under Section 458 (a)(5)(v) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the sangguniang panlungsod is mandated to "regulate the putting up of signs, signposts, awnings and awning posts on the streets";

WHEREAS, it is an opportune time to refurbish dilapidated street signs of District II and to install new signages making all street signs of District II of Quezon City uniform;

WHEREAS, such street signs shall include, but shall not be limited to, signs indicating the name of public roads and streets, road signs and traffic signs;

WHEREAS, street names of major roads and thoroughfares must be properly illuminated.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All street signs in Quezon City shall be uniform, with District II as the pilot area.


SECTION 2. The amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated from any available funds of the City government for the initial implementation of the aforesaid undertaking.


SECTION 3. The Parks Development and Administration Department and the Engineering Department shall come out with the cost estimate of the aforementioned project.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




