Ordinance No. SP-1234, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE NAMING AN UNNAMED STREET IN BARANGAY SAN ANTONIO, AREA 2, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, TO GERARDO G. PASCO STREET.

Introduced by Councilors ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, WILMA AMORANTO-SARINO, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY and ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS.

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay San Antonio, District I of this City has passed Resolution No. 179, S-99, expressing the desire to name a portion of Capillan St. from Fernandez St. to Santiago Extension thereat to Gerardo G. Pasco Street;

WHEREAS, the National Historical Institute, expressed their conformity to the naming of the unnamed street in Barangay San Antonio Area 2, District I, Quezon City, to Gerardo G. Pasco Street;

WHEREAS, the unnamed street is perpendicular to Sto. Niño and Fernandez Street and has been erroneously referred to as part of Sto. Niño Street and likewise, that said street does not disrupt the continuity of Capillan Street;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay San Antonio with the concurrence of the residents of the said street has recommended the naming of the said street to Gerardo G. Pasco Street in honor of the first Barangay captain of Barangay San Antonio whose dedication to duty was worthy of emulation and whose character was beyond reproach;

WHEREAS, naming the unnamed street to Gerardo G. Pasco Street will serve to commemorate and honor a man who, by the account of his community, has served as a good example to the citizenry.


NOW, THEREFORE,

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval




