ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1259, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION AND COMPOSITION OF THE VETERANS ASSISTANCE COMMITTEE OF QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, JORGE L. BANAL, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and JANET M. MALAYA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. Short Title - This Ordinance shall be known as "The Quezon City Veterans Assistance Committee Ordinance".

Section 2. Creation and Composition of a Veterans Assistance Committee - There is hereby created a Veterans Assistance Committee, which shall be composed of the following:

- a. Majority Floor Leader of the City Council - Chairman
- b. Chairman of the Committee on Appropriation - Vice Chairman
- c. Representative from the Veterans Federation of the Philippines - Member
- d. Representative from the Armed Forces of the Philippines Retired Veterans Association - Member
- e. City Treasurer - Member

Section 3. Powers and Functions of the Committee - The Veterans Assistance Committee shall exercise the following powers and functions:

- a) The Committee shall have the power and authority to receive and evaluate applications for financial assistance for the burial expenses of accredited World War II, Korean War and Vietnam War Veterans who are bonafide residents of this City.

For this purpose, the Committee shall require the presentation of the following documents from a prospective claimant:

- a.1 Authenticated copy of death certificate of the veteran;
 - a.2 Authenticated copy of the marriage certificate, if the claimant is the surviving spouse of the veteran;
 - a.3 Authenticated copy of birth certificate, if the claimant is a surviving legitimate child of the deceased veteran;
 - a.4 Barangay certification stating therein that the deceased veteran is a bonafide resident of the barangay and that the claimant is the legitimate spouse or children of the deceased.
- b) The Committee shall have the power and authority to evaluate and determine the authenticity of the documents presented by the claimant;
 - c) The Committee shall have the power and authority to determine the qualification of the veteran and the person claiming the benefits of this ordinance;
 - d) The Committee shall exercise such other powers and functions necessary and proper to carry out its mandate.


Section 4. Meetings - The Committee shall meet every first Wednesday of the month at 10:00 in the morning at the Quezon City Hall or in any place designated by the Committee, which in no case shall be beyond the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City.

Section 5. Quorum - The presence of the majority of all the members of the committee shall constitute a quorum to transact business.

Section 6. Publication of Approved Application - All approved applications shall be forwarded to the Office of the City Council Secretary for inclusion in the agenda of the City Council for confirmation.


Section 7. Separability Clause - If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the Ordinance or the provision not otherwise affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

Section 8. Repealing Clause - All provisions of laws, orders, decrees, including rules and regulations and local legislative measures inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.




Section 9. Effectivity Clause - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




