AN ORDINANCE RENAMING DAMAYAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO CONGRESSMAN REYNALDO A. CALALAY MEMORIAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. Damayan Elementary School is hereby renamed to Congressman Reynaldo A. Calalay Memorial Elementary School.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




