ORDINANCE NO. SP-1351, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 22, SECTION 83 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-91, S-93, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "QUEZON CITY REVENUE CODE OF 1993," SO AS TO REQUIRE THE PERSONAL APPEARANCE AND THE PRESENTATION OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE OF PERSONS APPLYING FOR THE MAYOR'S PERMIT ON OCCUPATION OR CALLING.

WHEREAS, Section 458 of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides the City Council with the authority to regulate the establishment, operation and maintenance of entertainment and amusement;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that many establishments in Quezon City are hiring the services of minor persons below eighteen (18) years of age.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 83 of Article 22 (Mayor's Permit Fee on Occupation or Calling) of Ordinance No. SP-91, S-93, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Revenue Code of 1993" is hereby amended, to read as follows:

"Section 83. Administrative Provisions - It shall be unlawful for any person to exercise his occupation or calling within the jurisdiction of the City, without acquiring the individual Mayor's Permit. All persons applying for a Mayor's Permit on occupation or calling shall first secure police clearance and health certificate. Provided, that all persons applying for a Mayor's Permit to exercise his/her occupation or calling shall be required to personally appear in the Business Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO) and to present an authenticated and certified xerox copy of his/her birth certificate."


SECTION 2. Any ordinance, rules and regulations or parts hereof which is/are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


