ORDINANCE NO. SP-1354, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE APOLONIO SAMSON HIGH SCHOOL- IN BARANGAY APOLONIO SAMSON, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the promotion of quality education is among the priority goals of both the national and local government of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, towards that end, it is necessary that educational facilities be made easily accessible to all citizens, particularly the marginalized segments of our society;

WHEREAS, the creation, establishment and maintenance of a high school in Barangay Apolonio Samson, District II, Quezon City, will greatly benefit the people living in said area and its immediate environs, and contribute in no small way to making the opportunities and facilities of secondary education easily accessible to the poor.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created and established, under the Division of City Schools of Quezon City, a public high school to be known as the Apolonio Samson High School in Barangay Apolonio Samson, District II, Quezon City.


SECTION 2. The local government of Quezon City, in coordination with Barangay Apolonio Samson, and the Division of City Schools of Quezon City, shall determine and provide for the site for the said high school, and the school building necessary for the purpose.

SECTION 3. The initial funds necessary for the establishment and maintenance of said Apolonio Samson High School shall be taken from the Special Education Fund of Quezon City, which shall be appropriated through the Local School Board of the City, or any available fund in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated for other purposes, which shall be provided in the annual budget of the City.
