ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1372, S-2004

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SEVENTY-EIGHT (78) PLANTILLA POSITIONS IN THE QUEZON CITY POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the promotion and delivery of quality education is among the top priority programs of the government;

WHEREAS, in line with said program, the Quezon City local government provided for the creation of the Quezon City Polytechnic University (QCPU) located at Barangay San Bartolome, this City, which caters to the growing demand for easy access to the opportunities of quality education;

WHEREAS, there is a felt need to expand the capacity of said Quezon City Polytechnic University to deliver quality education in the area;

WHEREAS, in keeping with its demand, it is necessary to further create additional plantilla positions in said QCPU in order to improve its structural organization and strengthen its teaching and administrative staff.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created the Seventy-Eight plantilla positions in the Quezon City Polytechnic University as indicated in the personnel schedule which is attached herewith and made as an integral part hereof.



The present qualified contractual employees are hereby absorbed to be given appropriate position-title with commensurate salaries and benefits.


SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated for Personal Services, the amount of Seventeen Million Seven Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand and Twenty Pesos (P17,732,020.00) or so much as may be necessary for the purpose, out of the funds in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated for any other purpose.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




