



ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1378 , S-2004

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN ADDITIONAL ONE PESO (P1.00) TO ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY, FROM MARCH 1 TO 31, 2004, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE LAGARIAN CREEK ENVIRONMENTAL ASSOCIATION, INC. (LACREA) IN CONNECTION WITH ITS SAGIP BATIS PROJECT.



SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


