AN ORDINANCE ACCREDITING SEVENTY FIVE (75) NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS (NGOs) AND PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS (POs), PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 AND ITS IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS, IN RELATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2010-73.

WHEREAS, Section 34 of R.A. No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", provides that the Local Government Units shall promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991, particularly Article 64 of its Implementing Rules and Regulations provides, among others, that the local sanggunian concerned shall accredit non-governmental and people's organizations subject to the criteria and procedures provided therein for membership in the local special bodies;

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. SP-23, S-92, the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee was created to process applications for accreditation of non-governmental and people's organization;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Governmental Code of 1991 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2010-73 dated August 4, 2010, a Call for Accreditation was made by the Quezon City Council through the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee;

WHEREAS, these seventy five (75) non-governmental and people's organizations applied for accreditation with the Quezon City Council through the Community Relations Office;

WHEREAS, the applications of the said organizations were processed and considered by the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and favorably recommended their accreditation by the Quezon City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There are hereby accredited Seventy Five (75) Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and People's Organization (POs), pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, in relation with DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2010-73.

SECTION 2. The herein accredited organizations shall inform within 30 days the Quezon City Council, through the Office of the City Secretary, copy furnished the Community Relations Office, of any major changes in their organizations particularly with respect to their officers and addresses.


SECTION 3. The Quezon City Government, through the Office of the City Council Secretary in coordination with the Community Relations Office, shall prepare and issue Certificates of Accreditation to the herein accredited organizations duly signed by the City Mayor, the City Vice Mayor, the Chairman of the NGO and PO Accreditation Committee and attested by the City Council Secretary.




SECTION 4. The list of the accredited seventy five (75) NGOs/POs are hereby made as integral part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


