ORDINANCE NO. SP-441, S-96

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF DON ANTONIO AVENUE IN BARANGAY HOLY SPIRIT, QUEZON CITY, TO HOLY SPIRIT DRIVE.

WHEREAS, Don Antonio Avenue is a city road branching out from Commonwealth Avenue going through various interior subdivisions down to Barangay Fairview;

WHEREAS, because the first subdivision it passes through is the Don Antonio Subdivision, it gives the impression that Don Antonio Avenue is a private road being part of, or belonging to Don Antonio Subdivision;

WHEREAS, in order to obviate such misapprehension and giving weight to the sentiment of the residents in the said barangay as enunciated in a resolution of the BF Homeowners Community Association, Inc. dated 3 February 1996, as well as in Resolution No. 1, S-96 of Barangay Holy Spirit, in that "to establish its identity as a government road and give emphasis to the locality since this leads to the Barangay Hall, x x x the name of Don Antonio Avenue be changed to Holy Spirit Drive".

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The name of Don Antonio Avenue which branches out from Commonwealth Avenue through Don Antonio Subdivision in Barangay Holy Spirit, is hereby changed to Holy Spirit Drive.

5. Business Permits and Licensing Office;
6. Office of the City Assessor.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
