

ORDINANCE Numbered 2336

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE PLACING OF NUMBERS AT ANY DWELLING HOUSE OR BUILDING IN QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of Quezon City, that:

SECTION 1. In order to have a uniform, systematic and accurate numbering of houses or buildings, the City Engineer is authorized to cause the numbering or renumbering of houses or buildings in Quezon City.

SEC. 2. Placing of Numbers. - The City Engineer shall assign a number to each and every dwelling house or building fronting on any street, lane, alley, or other public places in Quezon City. The plate number shall be placed by the owner of the house or building in accordance with the system and plan prescribed by the City Engineer with regards to class, form, shape and location of the plate number.

SEC. 3. The amount of two pesos (₱2.00) shall be paid to the City Treasurer by the owner of the dwelling house or building for every number issued under this Ordinance. For the renumbering of said houses or buildings the amount of One peso and Fifty centavos (₱1.50) shall be paid to the City Treasurer by the owner of the said dwelling house or building.

SEC. 4. Taking down, alteration, defacing, etc., of numbers. - It shall be unlawful for any person to take down, alter, or deface any number plate, or to obtain an improper number on the house or building other than the one prescribed by the City Engineer. This section shall not prohibit the replacing of a worn-out or illegible number plate by a new plate bearing the same number as the old one.

SEC. 5. Penalty. - Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than ten pesos (₱10.00) nor more than two hundred pesos (₱200.00) or by imprisonment of not less than five (5) days nor more than six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 6. Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SEC. 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
