ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2318, S-2014

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN ANNIVERSARY BONUS TO ALL REGULAR EMPLOYEES OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) AND THREE THOUSAND PESOS (P3,000.00) TO ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES ON THE OCCASION OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE 75TH FOUNDATION DAY ANNIVERSARY OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Units are allowed to grant an Anniversary Bonus to its employees as provided under Administrative Order No. 316 of the Office of the President;

WHEREAS, Quezon City is considered now as a "city of achievements" because of its numerous positive achievements and as recipient of various awards which surpassed the past records, like the establishments of business centers, preservations of cultural heritage, provisions of necessary recreational areas, school buildings, day care centers and other infrastructure projects, among others;

WHEREAS, it is also reported that our general fund has excellently increased compared in the previous years, and in fact, we are now almost considered as the richest city in the Metropolis;

WHEREAS, all the good things we have achieved would not have come to pass were it not for the hard work, industry, and efficiency services of the legions of personnel and employees of the City government who are at the forefront in the delivery of basic public services;

WHEREAS, as we celebrate the 75th Anniversary of the founding of Quezon City on October 12, 2014, it is but fit and proper that Quezon City extends its gratitude to its employees by way of providing them with an anniversary bonus as authorized under existing laws, rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. An Anniversary Bonus is hereby granted to all regular employees in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) to all other employees on the occasion of the celebration of the 75th Anniversary of the founding of Quezon City on October 12, 2014.


SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the amount of Forty Four Million Nine Hundred Twenty Thousand Pesos (P44,920,000.00) or so much as may be necessary for the purpose, out of the funds of the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated for any other purpose.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


