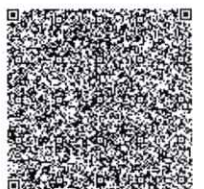

WHEREAS, education remains a vital pillar in the social and economic development of Quezon City, and partnerships with educational institutions are essential in advancing quality, accessible, and inclusive learning opportunities for its constituents;

WHEREAS, various private educational institutions have expressed willingness to collaborate with the Quezon City Government in the implementation of scholarship programs and other related initiatives beneficial to the residents of the City;

WHEREAS, entering into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with these private educational institutions will provide a clear framework for cooperation, define roles and responsibilities, and ensure the effective and transparent implementation of joint educational undertakings;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government, through the authority of the Honorable City Mayor, is empowered to enter into agreements and contracts consistent with existing laws, ordinances, and policies for the purpose of promoting the general welfare of its constituents;

WHEREAS, as part of the Quezon City Scholarship Program, the Quezon City Youth Development Office (QCYDO) collaborates with the following private educational institutions:

1. National Teacher's College;
2. Polytechnic University of the Philippines;
3. Rizal Technological University;
4. Philippine Normal University;
5. Lyceum of the Philippines University;
6. PHINMA St. Jude College; and
7. University of Santo Tomas.

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Quezon City Government and the abovementioned educational institutions shall streamline the processes, including the verification of student qualifications, enrolment status, and academic performance, thereby ensuring the timely and accurate provision of benefits to scholars;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government welcomes the participation of other private and public educational institutions willing to collaborate in the implementation of the City's scholarship programs;

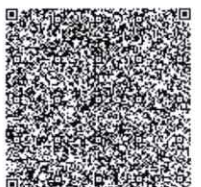
WHEREAS, in all its business transactions, it is incumbent upon the City Mayor to represent the City and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance as provided in Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

NOW, THEREFORE,


