ORDINANCE NO. SP- **3437**, S-2025

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A ONE-SIDE PARKING AND ONE-WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME ALONG THE CIRCUMFERENTIAL ACCESS ROAD OF POOK SIKATUNA BLISS PHASE 1, BARANGAY UP CAMPUS, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 458(a)(5)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to the said Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein;

WHEREAS, Section 458(a)(5)(v) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the powers, duties and functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod as follows:

“(v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; regulate garages and operation of conveyances for hire; designate stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting up of signs, signposts, awnings and awning posts on the streets; and provide for the lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets and public places;

(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon, and when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal or encroachments and illegal constructions in public places”;

WHEREAS, the increasing volume of vehicular traffic along the circumferential access road of Pook Sikatuna Bliss Phase 1, Barangay UP Campus has caused significant congestion, delays and public safety concerns;

WHEREAS, the existing limited road space necessitates a systematic approach to traffic management to ensure the smooth and safe flow of traffic;

WHEREAS, the implementation of a one-side parking and one-way traffic scheme is deemed necessary to address these concerns and improve traffic conditions in the area;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay UP Campus, with a Letter of No Objection dated July 16, 2024 from the Traffic and Transport Management Department of Quezon City, has formally requested the enactment of a City Ordinance to implement Barangay Resolution No. 023, S-2024 dated May 22, 2024 entitled “A Barangay Resolution Approving the Implementation of One-Side Parking for Motor Vehicles on the Circumferential Access Road of Pook Sikatuna Bliss Phase 1, Barangay UP Campus, Diliman, Quezon City”.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as “An Ordinance Establishing a One-Side Parking and One-Way Traffic Scheme Along the Circumferential Access Road of Pook Sikatuna Bliss Phase 1, Barangay UP Campus, District IV, Quezon City.”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. – It is hereby declared the policy of the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay UP Campus to establish a one-side parking and one-way traffic scheme along the circumferential access road of Pook Sikatuna Bliss Phase 1 to address traffic congestion, improve traffic flow, enhance public safety and promote order within the said Barangay.

SECTION 3. TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME. – The Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay UP Campus, upon recommendation from Barangay Traffic Committee, may designate specific sections of the circumferential access road of Pook Sikatuna Bliss, Phase 1, Barangay UP Campus, Quezon City.

SECTION 4. ILLEGAL PARKING AND OBSTRUCTION. – Motor vehicles shall, in adopting the Metro Manila Traffic Code of 2023, not be allowed to obstruct or otherwise park in front of any established road right-of-way, private or public driveways, hospitals or clinics, provision for human ingress and anywhere within four (4) meters from fire hydrant of public safety utility. The owners of such vehicles are also prohibited from reserving portions of the streets of Barangay UP Campus as their parking spaces, nor are they allowed to park within ten (10) meters of an intersection at an intersection road without a traffic light unless it is a designated parking space of Barangay UP Campus.

SECTION 5. PASSENGERS, ARTICULATED VEHICLES AND VEHICLES USED FOR BUSINESS. – Pursuant to the Metro Manila Traffic Code of 2023, vehicles used for business or delivery are prohibited from staying more than ten (10) minutes and are not included in one-side parking schemes for the purpose of loading and unloading cargoes unless permitted by the Barangay.

Articulated vehicles must obtain a permit from the Barangay.

SECTION 6. EXEMPTIONS. – *The following vehicles and situations are exempted from traffic restrictions:*

- a. Emergency Vehicles (ambulances, fire trucks, police cars, etc.);*
- b. Vehicles engaged in emergency services (e.g. utility repair crews);*
- c. Vehicles with special permits issued by the Punong Barangay (for justifiable reasons, such as deliveries during restricted hours).*

SECTION 7. SIGNAGES AND MARKINGS. – *The Punong Barangay shall ensure the installation of adequate and clearly visible signages and pavement markings to indicate the designated traffic flow, parking restrictions and exemptions on all affected streets.*

SECTION 8. ENFORCEMENT. – *The Traffic and Transport Management Department (TTMD) of Quezon City, with the assistance of Barangay, Deputized Traffic Enforcers and members of the Sangguniang Barangay are hereby authorized and empowered to administer and implement all rules and regulations relative to this Ordinance. All existing Quezon City ordinances related to traffic management are hereby adopted subject to the authority or deputization of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority.*

SECTION 9. PENALTIES. – *Violation of any of the provision of this Ordinance is subject to the issuance of the Unified Ordinance Violation Receipt (UOVR), as well as payment of the corresponding fines, as provided under Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3172, S-2023.*

SECTION 10. REVIEW AND AMENDMENT. – *The Sangguniang Barangay shall review the effectiveness of this Ordinance from its effectivity and may amend or modify its provisions as deemed necessary to address changing traffic conditions and needs.*

SECTION 11. DEPUTIZATION. – *To enforce the provisions of this Ordinance, the Sangguniang Barangay of UP Campus will arrange for qualified personnel, including, but not limited to, the Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSOs), as its Barangay Deputized Traffic Enforcers, who shall undergo training and deputization from the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority.*

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – *In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.*

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. – *All ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders, rules and regulations or any part thereof inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed, modified or amended accordingly.*

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation, and after posting of copies in conspicuous locations within Quezon City.
