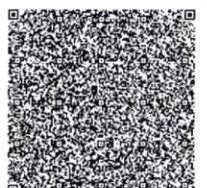

NOW, THEREFORE,



RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the members of the Philippine Girls Bowling Team in recognition of their outstanding achievement.


