# The 38 Years of QCCCI



**S**ome 37 years ago, there was no chamber of commerce and industry in Quezon City. There was a loose conglomeration of businessmen each one intent in doing his own thing.

But times were hanging.

As the city grew and commerce flourished, the need was felt for an organization that would steer free enterprise the way it should go to better serve an expanding population.

## **1960: THE BEGINNING**

One fine day, a select group of businessmen got together to lay down the foundation of just such an organization. The date: March 17, 1960. The place: the D & E Restaurant on Quezon Boulevard. The businessmen: Ernesto Sibal, Domingo Arcega, Ceferino Picache, Alfredo Lingad, Modesto Enriquez, Col. Sergio Sanchez, Edmun Kaimo, and Dominador Cepeda.

Out of that historic meeting was born the Quezon City Chamber of Commerce & Industry. Its objectives were defined as, primarily, to unite the leaders of the City's business community to better promote trade, commerce, and industry; Secondly: It would help in anyway possible to develop the community where the members had chosen to establish and operate their business ventures.

Elected president was Ernesto Sibal.

## **1961: BUILDING UP MEMBERSHIP**

Domingo Arcega succeeded Ernesto Sibal to the presidency. By this time the Chamber had already drafted the organization's constitution and by-laws. The Chamber's seal and banner were also designed. As portrayed by a hand lifting the various industries in Quezon City, the seal symbolized the objectives of the Chamber and the unity of its members.

Upon the invitation of Modesto Enriquez, the Chamber set up its offices at the D & E

Restaurant compound. It was to be the QCCCI's home for the next 13 years.

The early years of the Chamber were devoted to building up membership, setting up procedures and patterns of action, and establishing contacts with the City and National government offices.

## **1962: THE QCCCI'S FIRST BIG PROJECT**

In the elections for the 1962 fiscal year, Domingo Arcega was re-elected to the Presidency. Under his administration, the Chamber undertook its first giant project: the sponsorship of the first Quezon City Trade Fair. It was held on a sprawling 3-hectare site in front of the Araneta Coliseum in Cubao.

Keynoted by the theme "Buy Philippine," the Trade Fair had the official sanction and support of the national Government. The Department of Commerce and Industry, at the time under Secretary Manuel Lim, allotted P10,000 for the Fair from its Trade Promotion Funds.

The Trade Fair was a resounding success, visited by record crowds daily. A highlight of the Fair was the exhibition by the QCCCI of a model economy house which was raffled off at the close of the Fair to the lucky winner.

So successful was the fair that although it was originally scheduled for only one month, it was extended due to public demand. It lasted from February 17, 1962 to April 15, 1962.

## **1963: THE MUNICIPAL FARE CODE**

In 1963, under the incumbency of president Ceferino M. Picache, the Chamber made representations with the Quezon City Government for the passage of the Municipal Fare Code. It was subsequently approved and duly signed into an ordinance by Mayor Norberto Amoranto.

## **1964: TAX COLLECTION CAMPAIGN**

By 1964, the Chamber was in active cooperation with the Quezon City government.

Under President Alfredo Lingad, the Chamber helped in the campaign for the collection of taxes in Quezon City.

The Chamber was always available to act as a consultant to the City government in matters affecting business and industry.

#### **1965: MOTORCYCLES FOR QCPD**

Ramon Hechanova took over the QCCCI presidency in 1965. Under his able leadership the Chamber continued to serve the various needs of its members and Quezon City businessmen in general.

It was during this time that the Chamber learned of the need for vehicles of the Quezon City Police Department in its drive against lawlessness. Eager to be of help, the Chamber raised the funds to acquire four (4) brand new Honda motorcycles with side-cars and donated them to the law enforcement unit.

The donation helped mounted Quezon City policemen in the performance of their duties, not only in the fight against crime but also to ease the worsening traffic situation in the rapidly growing City.

For its donation, the Chamber was the recipient of an appreciation plaque from the Quezon City Police Department.

#### **1966: REAL ESTATE TAX CAMPAIGN**

Modesto Enriquez's term as President in 1966 was highlighted by a campaign to help the City government collect real estate taxes. This was done after the realization that the City Government could vigorously pursue developmental projects aimed at public service only with increased city revenues.

#### **1967: EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 23**

A retired army colonel, Sergio Sanchez, was elected to the presidency of the Chamber in 1967. He worked to have the QCCCI named as the consultative body of the Quezon City government in all matters pertaining to commerce and industry.

The result was Quezon City executive Order No. 23 duly signed by Mayor Norberto Amoranto, officially appointing the QCCCI as the City government's consultative body on commerce and industry.

During this time, the Chamber started the publication of a newsletter to chronicle its monthly activities. It was named the Chamber Journal, forerunner of the present Chamber News.

#### **1968: A SAD YEAR**

This was a sad year for the QCCCI. Newly elected president Pedro Lanuza died before he could officially be inducted into office. Then Vice President Vicente Formoso assumed the Presidency and led the Chamber through a year marked by the recruitment of a greater number of new members.

#### **1969: QUEZON CITY TRADE & BUSINESS DIRECTORY**

In the elections for 1969, Vicente Formoso won over all the other nominees and continued the term he had started as President the previous year. His biggest project was the preparation, compilation, and publication of the 1st Quezon City Trade & Business Directory. Composed of 100 pages, the Directory was a major achievement, the first of its kind in Quezon City and neighboring municipalities.

#### **1970: BUSINESS SEMINARS**

The QCCCI began the decade of the seventies under the Presidency of Benedicto Chupungco. He ably steered the Chamber into greater involvement with the business world, initiating development seminars for executives in the supervisory and managerial levels.

The seminars were intended to upgrade the skills of those who were running the affairs of business establishments in the City, with the ultimate objective of improving the City's business climate.

#### **1971: SMALL BUSINESS CLINIC**

In the elections for 1971, a lawyer, Bartimeo Velasquez, was given the responsibility of guiding the affairs of the Chamber. Under his leadership, the QCCCI launched a project aimed at helping small business establishments solve their problems. Thus was born the Small Business Clinic, formally inaugurated May 17, 1971 with then Commerce and Industry Secretary Ernesto M. Maceda as guest of honor.

#### **1972: "1081"**

1972 was the year of 1081, President Ferdinand E. Marcos' declaration of martial law all over the Philippines.

Ambrosio Flores was the president of the QCCCI. His immediate and most important task was to guide the Chamber towards fulfilling its obligations as a member of the emerging New Society.

### **1973: AN ARCHITECT'S PLANS**

An architect, Constancio Agbayani, became the QCCCI's president in 1973. True to his profession, Agbayani thought of a relevant project: to put up a building that the Chamber could rightfully call its own, where businessmen in Quezon City could meet and discuss their problems.

The ambitious project, however, could not be pushed through because of the lack of a suitable site. The architectural plans are still in existence, biding their time. At some more opportune time, maybe?

### **1974: A MOVE TO AMEND THE CHAMBERS CONSTITUTION & BY-LAWS**

After an architect an engineer followed in the presidency of the Chamber. He was Eduardo S. Gomez. During his term, he continued the Chamber's Seminars on the techniques of modern business management.

It was during his term that the move was launched to amend the QCCCI's Constitution and By-Laws. This was deemed necessary to make them more responsive to the needs of the changing times.

### **1975: WORKING WITH THE CITY GOVERNMENT**

This year saw the Chamber becoming more and more involved with the affairs of the City government. QCCCI President Feliciano Cabrera was officially invited by Quezon City Mayor Adelina Rodriguez to represent the private sector in the reorganization of the City government.

The program of conducting seminars to upgrade business managerial skills was vigorously pursued. During this time, the Chamber gained the distinction of having its President elected as the Governor of Region IV of the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

### **1976: A UNIQUE YEAR**

This was an unusual year for the Chamber in the matter of the tenure of its Directors and officers. Instead of lasting the usual 12-month period, it was extended for an additional six months for a total of eighteen (18) months. This was done to conform to a Decree issued by President Ferdinand E. Marcos declaring that the fiscal year should conform to the calendar year.

Thus, the terms of the newly elected officers and directors headed by President Greg. Sta. Maria started on July 1, 1976

(according to the old fiscal year) and stretched on until December 31 of the next year, 1977.

### **1977: ASEAN TRADE MISSION**

During President Greg Sta. Maria's 18-month long term, the Chamber undertook a vital project: the formation of a Trade Mission to Hongkong and ASEAN countries (Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, and Thailand).

Headed by President Sta. Maria himself, the Trade Mission had the official blessings of the Ministry of Trade and Ministry of Commerce and Industry. The Trade mission was composed of fifteen (15) QCCCI members, including then Vice President Tolomeo Ligutan.

The Trade mission was away for 21 days. Upon its return, President Sta. Maria made a formal report to the Chamber and pronounced the Trade Mission a success in establishing better business relations with neighboring countries in the South East Asian region.

### **1978: THE 2nd TRADE MISSION**

Vice President for 1977 Tolomeo D. Ligutan was elected to the presidency in 1978. A Certified Public Accountant, Ligutan launched a massive membership drive and continued the project of conducting supervisory & managerial seminars.

During his incumbency, a second Trade Mission journeyed abroad, this time to observe business conditions on a Chamber of Commerce to Chamber of Commerce level in Australia, New Zealand, and Singapore.

Headed by President Ligutan, the 2nd Trade Mission left on Sept. 25, 1978.

With its objectives of increasing Philippine exports and to promote Philippine tourism, the Trade Mission was given governmental status by Minister of Trade Troadio T. Quiazon.

Upon its return on October 12, 1978, President Ligutan, as head of the Mission, gave a report to the Chamber about the prospects of improving the country's exports.

### **1979: A CRUCIAL YEAR**

For the Chamber, this was a period of internal legal problems that needed to be resolved fast. It was a crucial time, indeed.

During an emergency meeting in March, 1979, young, dynamic businessman Rolando S. Asis was unanimously elected to the Presidency of the Chamber. Upon assuming office, President Asis lost no time in having all the internal legal problems speedily resolved satisfactorily.

The next month, April, the QCCCI moved to its new secretariat on the 4th floor of the Arcega Bldg., E. Rodriguez Ave.

President Asis became aware that the QCCCI's Constitution and By-laws, on file with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) since 1960, had not yet been approved by the governmental body because they (Constitution and By-laws) had never been ratified by the QCCCI members, a SEC prerequisite.

President Asis's immediate project was, therefore, to have the Chambers' Constitution and By-laws amended and ratified by the members of the Chamber, then filed with, and approved by the SEC. With the full backing of the Chamber President Asis was able to accomplish all this in record time. On September 29, 1979, the QCCCI's amended Constitution and By-Laws were officially approved by the SEC, authorizing the Chamber's incorporation and increasing the number of directors from 11 to 5.

That important project satisfactorily and speedily completed, President Asis launched the preparation and subsequent publication of a comprehensive Quezon City Business Directory, an important project sadly left untouched by the Chamber since the publication of the First Trade Directory in 1971.

The Quezon City Business Directory was completed in August 19, 1979, in time with the birth anniversary of the late Philippine President Manuel L. Quezon who was known as the "Father of Quezon City." It featured a listing of almost all the business establishments operating in Quezon City, with adequate information on the nature of each business, their addresses, and their telephone numbers.

Under the leadership of President Asis, the Chamber became more involved with the Quezon City government in business and civic affairs. An immense membership drive was launched. Chamber meetings were held with more regularity and greater member attendance. The monthly newsletter, only desultorily published during the past years, became a regular monthly publication.

Notable personages were invited to speak at membership meetings. Among them were the Assistant to the Metro Manila Governor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., Former Trade Minister Troadio Quiazon, Jr., Quezon City Mayor Adelina S. Rodriguez, former Senate President Gil J. Puyat and Australian Ambassador Richard A. Woolcott.

The Chamber was already gearing itself

for the forthcoming 20th anniversary celebration.

#### **1980: THE 20th YEAR**

On October 15, 1979, President Rolando Asis was unanimously re-elected President for the Chamber year 1980. Under the newly approved provisions of the Constitution and By-laws, elected with him were fifteen (15) members who would serve in the Board of Directors.

This election has been described as the "most orderly, smooth, and peaceful" in the history of the Chamber. It was an election where the spirit of unity and cooperation were reflected as an absolute manifestation of the trust and confidence in the dynamic new leadership with justice, fairness, and fair play."

Immediately, President Asis set in motion a program of activities for the celebration of an important milestone in the history of the QCCCI: its twentieth (20th) anniversary.

A move was started to have the City government proclaim the period from March 24 to 28 Quezon City Commerce and Industry week to coincide with the Chamber's 20th anniversary. The proclamation was officially signed by Mayor Adelina S. Rodriguez on February 8, 1980 upon the presentation of a resolution by the officers and directors of the QCCCI led by President Asis.

#### **1981-1982: CLOSER TIES WITH CITY GOVERNMENT**

During the term of Jesus M. Arcega, active chamber promotions for closer ties with the City government were undertaken alongside an extensive campaign for membership.

The participation of the Quezon City Chamberette was likewise encouraged and no effort was spared to generate well-attended general and board meetings. At the same time, the Chamber worked hand-in-hand with the City Treasurer to facilitate the issuance of business permits and licenses.

Pres. Arcega was also able to coordinate and call on the past presidents of the Chamber to give their utmost cooperation in making the Chamber bigger and more effective.

#### **1982-1984: TOP 200 CORPORATIONS**

On his second term as QCCCI President, Architect Greg Sta. Maria pursued the Chamber's objectives with greater vigor. It was

during this time that the QCCCI Foundation was organized to promote livelihood projects.

Another high point of his second term was the publication of the QUEZON CITY TOP 200 CORPORATIONS AND INDIVIDUALS, a joint project of the Quezon City Government and the QCCCI.

#### **1985: KEEPING THE "QCCCI FLAME" BURNING**

This was the year that saw the amendment of the By-laws of the Chamber for the third time. It did away with the use of proxies in the election of Directors. President Luis M. Garcia also renewed the joint meetings with the Chamberette.

The Chamber took a stand on many controversial issues, including the non-operation of the nuclear plant in Bataan. It invited guest speakers from opposing political camps to ventilate their contradictory views on the issues.

The Chamberette likewise honored all past presidents of the association in a very special meeting attended by then Mayor Adelina S. Rodriguez who declared that precise week as "Trade and Industry Week" in Quezon City

#### **1986: NEW GOVERNMENT TAKES OVER**

In the aftermath of the EDSA revolt that installed Mrs. Cory Aquino as President, the attitude of most businessmen was to "wait and see" until the economic climate becomes clear. This resulted in a slack in the Chamber's activities.

President Sixto Tongos initiated a vigorous campaign for new members but, despite this, very few responded and attended the meetings of the Chamber. When there was a squabble among the officers of the NCRC, the QCCCI initiated a move to abolish the NCRC which prompted the officers to make up.

During the same year, the QCCCI also published a "Manifesto to the new Government" listing the Chamber's suggestions on how government could be improved, including certain policies relative to the holding of local elections, appointment of OIC's and a proposal to increase the salaries of government employees.

#### **1987: A QCCCI FOUNDATION**

The term of President Quintin P. San Diego saw the Chamber further strengthened through various activities designed to increase membership and link up with the City government's economic development plans.

He also initiated the establishment of the QCCCI Foundation which initially drew the support of the members in terms of financial contributions. However, lack of interest by other members eventually caught up with its noble objectives and it died a natural death. One other highlight of Pres. San Diego's term was the signing of sister-chapter agreement with the Brunei Darrussalam Chamber of Commerce.

#### **1988: TRADE MISSION & BUSINESSMEN'S CONGRESS**

President Manuel J.S. Peña headed the Chamber's trade mission to South Korea, Japan and Taiwan from August 22 to September 3, 1988. The trade mission aimed to promote business opportunities between QCCCI members and their foreign counterparts as well as to establish friendly relations.

The Chamber was also tasked by the Quezon City government to handle the 1st Quezon City Government Businessmen's Congress with the theme: "Cooperation between the Government and Private Businessmen." It was during this time that the Chamber was given a greater role in the development of the City's economy with a QCCCI representative in the Quezon City Economic Development Board (EDB).

The 1988 board of directors and members also attended several international conventions held in Manila, Particularly the conference and Philippine Investors Forum, sponsored by the Board of Investments and attended by 231 foreign and local investors.

#### **1989: BANNER YEAR OF THE CHAMBER**

President Peña was elected to a second term and he lost no time in unwrapping a series of projects and activities to make the Chamber "on the ball". First was a dialogue between the QCCCI, the City Government and Hometel-Apartelle operators.

Apart from its participation in policy-making as a member of the QC Economic Development Board, the Chamber initiated the formation of "One Voice of Business" duly recognized by the City Government and other sectors. Several monthly membership meetings were held with top government officials and business personalities as speakers.

The Chamber also entered into a joint undertaking with businessmen from South Korea through a business consultation between the QCCCI and selected Korean companies.

In tandem with the Quezon City Civil Relations Office, the Chamber also helped in the formation of the West Avenue Business Establishments as tourism-oriented.

#### **1990: LINKAGES WITH CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS**

The term of President Jimmy Morelos saw the Chamber linking up with various civic groups such as Rotary, Lions, Toastmasters, Thursday Club and others through joint meetings. During this time, the Chamber was also able to increase membership as well as develop close relationships with the Mayor and City Council.

Many old members were enticed to once again be active in the affairs of the Chamber so much so that, at the end term of Pres. Morelos, the election of the new members of the Board of Directors was probably one of the best attended elections in the Chamber's history.

Monthly meetings were graced by such personalities as then Sen. Juan Ponce Enrile, Vice Mayor Charito Planas, Bulletin Publisher Nap Rama, Sen. Ernesto Maceda and James Dy, president of the Filipino Chinese Chamber of Commerce.

#### **1991: FURTHER STRENGTHENING OF TIES**

Interaction with the various civic groups gained further momentum during the term of Pres. Ely Cipriano. After a well-attended induction with Mayor Jun Simon a guest speaker and inducting officer, the Chamber held a series of joint general membership meeting with Rotary Clubs, the Q.C. Chamberette, Q.C. Realtors Board and other groups.

A productivity orientation seminar was conducted by the Chamber in cooperation with the Productivity and Development Academy of the Philippines. The Chamber also launched a humanitarian project by distributing cash and relief goods to the victims of the Mt. Pinatubo eruption held in San Narciso, Zambales.

These and other projects to keep the chamber humming with activity the whole year around.

#### **1992-1993: WIDENING THE CHAMBER'S HORIZONS**

One of the few who served the Chamber as President for two consecutive terms, Pres. Rustico "Boy" Mendoza implemented programs and projects which established greater interaction with the City

and National Governments, opened dialogues with outstanding personalities in business, politics and the bureaucracy, and reached out to business counterparts from neighboring countries.

The Chamber was given an Award of Excellence by the National Capital Region Council (NCRC) for posing the biggest number of membership growth for the year 1992. The Chamber likewise blazed the trail in improving the climate for labor-management relations through a Memorandum of Agreement for industrial peace with the militant Kilusang Mayo Uno (KMU), setting the stage for similar arrangements by other Chambers in the Metro Manila area.

In sum, the Chamber not only strengthened its foundation as a bulwark of businessmen and professionals in Quezon City but widened its horizons through seminars, workshops, meetings, outreach projects, local and foreign linkages, and wholesome fellowship among the members for the two years under review.

#### **1994: A YEAR OF ACHIEVEMENT - QCCCI Picked as Top Chamber in the NCR**

With the able and dedicated leadership of its President, Businessman-civic leader, Octavio E. Saulo, the QCCCI was adjudged the 1994 Most Outstanding Chamber in the National Capital Region, an annual, distinctive award given by the country's national business aggregation, the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI) during the closing ceremonies of the 20th Philippine Business Conference held at the Hotel Nikko, Manila Garden, Makati City.

The award affirms a separate award given by the National Capital Region Council (NCRC) panel of judges who unanimously chose the QCCCI as the Most Outstanding Chamber in the Metropolis on the basis of achievement in the areas of action program, participation in Regional Chamber affairs, membership growth and skills development program.

1994 was more than a year of strengthening ties with the city government. It was a year of full local government private cooperation. It was a year that saw the development of a unique form of partnership - one based on strong government leadership and highly pro-active private sector linkage.

Among the very important accomplishments of QCCCI during the Saulo

Administration was its active participation in various government programs including that of Foundation of the Quezon City Polytechnic, the series of consultative meetings with the four districts of Quezon City, and the Quezon City's Best Trade Fair held during the 55th Foundation Day of Quezon City where Past President Mendoza actively represented the Chamber at the planning and implementation stages.

Another significant achievement of QCCCI in 1994, was the sponsorship of two Train the Trainers Seminars in cooperation with the National Manpower and Youth Council. At least fifty (50) key positioned personnel of QCCCI member establishments were trained on leadership and management skills by competent and highly qualified Training Institutions.

#### **1995: CHAMBER'S MISSION - "To Build Our People To Build Our Businesses"**

This was a year marked by various meetings for all members with such notable personages as Speaker de Venecia and Mayor Mathay and business personalities as guests. In June, the Chamber hosted a Testimonial Dinner together with the Filipino-Chinese Community to mark the 20th year of Philippine diplomatic relations with the People's Republic of China. QCCCI also participated in business meetings and sessions with various foreign trade missions and workshops sponsored by PCCI.

Four issues of its Quarterly Newsletter were published and distributed free to all its members.

The QCCCI won significant awards in at least two contests conducted by PCCI, NCR and ZDH - Technonet - Asia and was given the "Best Attendance Award" in the E.G. Ong Cup Bowling Tournament among various chambers in the NCR. This year also marked a 24% increase in its membership.

Under the able and competent leadership of its President, Atty. Mojamito R. Libunao, Jr., a position paper was issued on the proposed Revised Schedule of Fair Market Values in Quezon City increasing realty taxes by as much as 500% to 3,000%. The major points raised by QCCCI were adopted and passed as an Ordinance by the City Council providing for gradual implementation over a three-year period of any proposed increases, exempting properties which cannot be utilized because of squatter occupants from any increases, and reducing the fair market valuation as recommended by the City Assessor.

Corollary to its vision "To Build Our Business to Build Our Country," the Chamber sponsored 17 training programs among its members. This was conducted by professional training groups through a grant of One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) from the World Bank through TESDA (Technical Education and Skills Development Authority).

In the same year, Mayor Ismael A. Mathay, Jr. approved several petitions made by the Chamber including the facilitation of the issuance of business permits and licenses to accredited QCCCI members, proper consultation with the Chamber on prospective tax revisions or tax legislations, proper consultation on city projects affecting business establishments or their operations and the inclusion of the Chamber in the launching of projects where businessmen can extend support and assistance.

Before the end of the year, another significant achievement of Pres. Libunao's administration was the recognition of five outstanding officers and directors of the Chamber who contributed to its cause and worked the hardest to bring QCCCI where it is now.

#### **1996: EFFECTIVE ADVOCACY PROGRAM**

Under the leadership of Atty. Mojamito R. Libunao, Jr., who served as President on his second term in 1996, QCCCI continued to pursue the Chamber's objectives and successfully achieved them.

During the year, QCCCI was actively involved in Policy-making. First was its initiative to abort the Ordinance on Realty Tax increase in Quezon City urging the Quezon City Trial Court to issue a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) on City Ordinance 357. Second was the abolition of Mechanical Permit Fees for the installation of Machineries and Mechanical Equipments. Third was the position of Cubao Merchants Association, an affiliate member of the QCCCI, opposing the relocation of EDSA-LRT station from the South of Aurora Boulevard to North farther away from Quezon City's Central Business District. Lastly, QCCCI called for the implementation of the City Ordinance (NC-54, S-88 as amended NC-84, S-89) designating a nominee of the QCCCI to be a member of the Quezon City Development Board.

Through an aggressive and sustained membership drive, the Chamber strengthened its ranks which grew to 500 corporate and

individual members compared to 291 in 1995 and 232 in 1994. In addition, QCCCI counts on the support of the 2,150 members of the Cubao Merchants Association who have officially affiliated with the Chamber.

In its continued effort to provide services to its members, the QCCCI and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) - NCR signed an agreement for six programs for the 1996 Training Programs of the Industry Capability Build-Up Plan. Not only did this benefit the members but the Chamber itself as it generated income from conducting said programs and from another two NPC-consultation-workshops.

An agreement was entered into by QCCCI and the National Power Corporation (NPC) to keep the public abreast with the government thrust to restructure the Philippine energy sector and privatize the National Power Corporation (NPC). To accomplish this, QCCCI was tasked to organize two (2) consultation-workshops.

Embarking on programs and projects for the community at large also highlighted the year for 1996. Its attention was focused on the least fortunate - the disabled young people whom it believes could still be transformed into useful and independent citizens. To do so, QCCCI searched for talented deafmutes and trained them. After the training, performances were booked for them where the audience gave voluntary contributions. To expand the program, QCCCI continues to search for more deafmute talents and to institutionalize this enterprise, has put up the Pilipinas Foundation, where QCCCI officers are the prime movers.

In addition to various services rendered to members, the QCCCI has attracted many Quezon City businessmen and professionals to its monthly meetings which were always well-attended by a minimum of 120 to a maximum of 350 and during which information and views were exchanged and opportunities for networking were established.

#### **1997: QCCCI CONFERRED THE AWARD "MOST OUTSTANDING CHAMBER IN NCR"**

A distinctive award "Most Outstanding Chamber in the National Capital Region for 1997" was bestowed upon QCCCI under the competent, able and dedicated leadership of its President, Businessman-lawyer, Eduardo M. Agustin. The recognition was given to the Chamber by the country's national business aggrupation, the Philippine Chamber of

Commerce and Industry (PCCI), during the 23rd Philippine Business Conference held in Cebu City.

The vision of President Agustin to encourage the participation of Micro, Small and Medium Scale Industries moved the Chamber to give recognition to individuals who initiated or started their worthy enterprise, which thru their able management, has grown big and successful, and worthy of emulation and respect by the community in which they serve. Five (5) individuals coming from various business sectors received the "Outstanding Entrepreneur of Quezon City" award: Education, Marketing, Construction, Engineering, and Refrigeration and Airconditioning.

The promotion of business activity amongst Quezon City businessmen marked the year 1997 for the Chamber. Thus, a noteworthy achievement of publishing its most comprehensive 1997-1998 QCCCI Trade and Industry Directory was realized through the commitment of and hard work exerted by Chairman Elsie Delgado.

Emphasis on trade inter-action between members, cooperation with reciprocal transactions, and spirit of community and brotherhood in businesses was materialized through the Trade Discount Program under the Business Development Plan. The Trade Discount Program kicked off its Launching Ceremony marked by the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between QCCCI and Loyola Education Systems, Inc. (LESI), during one of its General Membership Meetings.

The administration of President Eduardo M. Agustin also initiated the move to acquire a permanent office for the QCCCI Secretariat to facilitate the dissemination of information to members. For this purpose, monetary contributions from Chamber officers and members started coming in to the Building Project Fund.

Other highlight of activities include Monthly General Membership Meetings graced by notable personalities both from the business and government sectors. Productivity and Management Training Seminar-workshops were also conducted among employees of member-companies. Lastly, inter-action with the City Government was strengthened through series of dialogues on the filing, issuance and approval of business permits•
