WHEREAS, the Philippine Tourism, both in the national and local level has become dynamic in keeping with the standards of world competitiveness;

WHEREAS, Filipino customs and traditions are potential tourism resources, therefore, there is a need to preserve, enhance and promote these resources;

WHEREAS, the City government believes that Quezon City has a reservoir of potential places for tourist attraction, both foreign and local, that can be found in its barangay units suitable for development through a more effective system of identification and assessment through the efforts of and coordination by the barangay units;

WHEREAS, to build and sharpen the substantive profile of Quezon City as a tourist area, it has to enhance the capabilities of its barangay units through the creation of a Barangay Tourism Council that can help the City government in identifying areas, developing approaches and programs in tourism and in promoting the historical, cultural and native values of Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"The City government of Quezon City hereby mandates the creation of a Barangay Tourism Council in each and every 142 barangay units of Quezon City. The Barangay Tourism Council must be a public-private sector initiative with the Quezon City Tourism Council as its umbrella/mother organization."**

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"Functions and Responsibilities.** The Barangay Tourism Council shall have the following functions and responsibilities:

- a. Provide inputs for the formulation of plans and strategies to develop, promote and sustain Quezon City's wealth, products and other resources for tourism purpose.**
- b. Adopt and enliven Quezon City's history, native culture and arts which can be utilized as tourist attractions.**
- c. Develop expansive programs and projects to enhance barangay's natural and man-made attractions for tourism purposes.**
- d. Implement projects and programs of the City government relating to Tourism and coordinate Barangay related activities with the Quezon City Tourism Council.**

e. **Mobilize barangay residents to participate in barangay's tourism activities.**

f. **Do such other tasks and acts for the promotion of City/Barangay Tourism Program.**

g. **Make an inventory of tourism attractions and potential tourism resources of the barangay."**

SECTION 3. Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"Composition. - The Barangay Tourism Council shall be composed of:**

- a. The Barangay Captain
- b. The Barangay Kagawad in charge of Tourism
- c. The Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Chairman of the Barangay
- d. A representative from the tourism business sector in the barangay
- e. A representative from Civic Organization or NGO in the barangay
- f. An Official Coordinator/Representative from the Women's Group in the barangay
- g. A representative or Teacher Coordinator from the Educational Sector in the barangay
- h. Interested people/stakeholders from tourism establishments/group."**

SECTION 4. Section 4 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"Compensation. - The Chairman, the barangay kagawad and SK Chairman shall perform duties as such without any compensation or remuneration. Members/representative thereof shall be on voluntary basis."**

SECTION 5. Section 5 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"Meetings. - The Barangay Tourism Council shall conduct regular meetings as scheduled by the Chairman and/or as may be required by the Quezon City Tourism Council."**

SECTION 6. Section 6 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"Secretariat. - There is hereby constituted on each barangay council a secretariat which shall be responsible for providing technical support, documentation, preparation of reports and such other assistance as may be required in the discharge of its functions. The Barangay Tourism Council may avail the services of any employee of the Barangay for this purpose or may hire employees to serve as secretariat if funds allow."**

SECTION 7. Section 7 of Ordinance No. SP-1651, S-2006 is hereby amended to read as follows :

**"Relation of the Barangay Tourism Council with the Quezon City Tourism Council shall be as follows:**



a. The policies, programs and projects of Barangay Tourism Council **must be submitted to the Quezon City Tourism Council for monitoring and consolidation purposes.**


b. The **Quezon City Tourism Council may call on Barangay Tourism Council for coordination and inputs."**

SECTION 8. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


