ORDINANCE Numbered 1105 / S 1951

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CARRYING OR USE OF SLING SHOTS (TIRADOR) AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or use a sling shot (Tirador) within the jurisdiction of Quezon City.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, a "sling shot" or "tirador" shall be construed to mean a device consisting of elastic rubber bands tied to a forked twig or metal which is used to throw or fling a stone or other missile.

SEC. 2. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punished by confiscation of the sling shot in addition to a fine of not more than ten pesos (P10.00) or by an imprisonment of not more than four (4) days or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SEC. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
