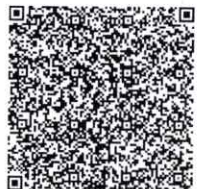

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 11, Article XIII of the said Act provides that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development to make essential goods, health, and social services available to all people at affordable cost;

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WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 491, otherwise known as the "Nutrition Act of the Philippines," created the National Nutrition Council and mandates all local government units to formulate, adopt, and implement Local Nutrition Action Plans consistent with national nutrition policies and standards;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates the devolution of basic health, nutrition, and social welfare services to local government units and requires the integration of sectoral plans into the Local Development Plan and Annual Investment Program;

WHEREAS, malnutrition remains a critical public health and development concern that affects child survival, maternal health, educational performance, productivity, and long-term human capital development;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Nutrition Committee (QCNC), chaired by the City Mayor, serves as the City's policy-making and coordinating body for nutrition and is mandated to formulate and periodically update the City's Nutrition Action Plan;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Local Nutrition Action Plan (QC LNAP) 2026 was developed through a consultative and data-driven process, incorporating local nutrition situation analysis, program performance reviews, and updated priority targets for the Year 2026;

WHEREAS, the QC LNAP 2026 adopts a strengthened life-cycle approach to nutrition, ensuring interventions across pregnancy, infancy, early childhood, school-age years, adolescence, and other nutritionally-vulnerable groups;

WHEREAS, the QC LNAP 2026 integrates nutrition-specific interventions such as micronutrient supplementation, maternal nutrition services, infant and young child feeding promotion, complementary feeding programs, and growth monitoring with nutrition-sensitive and enabling strategies including food security initiatives, healthy food environment policies, social protection, urban agriculture promotion, and community mobilization;

WHEREAS, the QC LNAP 2026 contains a comprehensive Program, Projects, and Activities (PPA) matrix with defined targets, timelines, responsible offices, financing strategies, and monitoring and evaluation mechanisms to ensure measurable and accountable implementation;

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WHEREAS, the QC LNAP 2026 aligns with the Philippine Plan of Action for Nutrition (PPAN) 2023-2028, the Regional Plan of Action for Nutrition (RPAN), the Philippine Development Plan, Ambisyon Natin 2040, and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), particularly SDG 2 (Zero Hunger) and SDG 3 (Good Health and Well-Being);

WHEREAS, the QC LNAP 2026 serves as a basis for nutrition integration in the City's Local Development Plan and Annual Investment Program, ensuring that nutrition remains a cross-cutting priority in governance and budgeting;

WHEREAS, institutionalizing the QC LNAP 2026 as the City's official nutrition roadmap strengthens inter-agency convergence, enhances performance accountability, and ensures systematic monitoring of nutrition outcomes for Calendar Year 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to adopt, as it does hereby adopt, the Quezon City Local Nutrition Action Plan (QC LNAP) 2026 as the City's Nutrition Roadmap and Convergence Framework for Calendar Year 2026.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that all concerned City Departments, Offices, and Barangays are hereby directed to align and integrate the goals, strategies, targets, and indicators set forth in the QC LNAP 2026 into their respective annual work plans, programs, and budget proposals.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the Quezon City Nutrition Committee (QCNC) shall oversee the coordinated implementation of the QC LNAP 2026, ensure quarterly monitoring of key nutrition indicators, and conduct an Annual Program Implementation Review to assess progress and recommend policy or program adjustments as necessary.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that partnerships with national government agencies, civil society organizations, academic institutions, private sector entities, and development partners are hereby encouraged to support and strengthen the implementation of the QC LNAP 2026.

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RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of the Quezon City Local Nutrition Action Plan 2026 shall form an integral part of this Resolution and copies hereof be furnished to all concerned offices for their information, guidance, and appropriate action.
