WHEREAS, Project 6 Day C  nitroPDF professional is already dilapidated and there is an urgent need to construct a new building; \*

WHEREAS, the construction of the Day Care Center is likewise proposed so as to ensure the effective delivery and access to quality education of Day Care students and to accommodate the increasing number of student enrollees;

WHEREAS, in order to achieve the aforesaid objective, it is necessary to construct a new Project 6 Day Care Center in order to satisfy the aforesaid need.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Office of the City Engineer is hereby mandated to make the necessary plans and costs estimates for the construction of a new Project 6 Day Care Center.

SECTION 2. Copies of such plans and costs estimates shall be submitted to the Office of the City Mayor, the Office of the City Budget Officer and the Office of the City Treasurer.

SECTION 3. After receipt of the said plans and costs estimates, the City Budget Officer shall allocate from the existing infrastructure or other budget of the City the amount necessary therefor or include the costs therefore in the City's annual or supplemental budgetary appropriations for the year immediately succeeding the date of approval of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. Thereafter, the City Engineer shall immediately effect the construction of said building in accordance with existing rules and regulations.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


