A RESOLUTION URGING ALL CONCERNED DEPARTMENTS AND OFFICES OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT TO ACTIVELY COORDINATE WITH AND EXTEND FULL TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (QCHD) FOR THE IMMEDIATE FORMULATION OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS (IRR) OF QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-3285, S-2024 AND QUEZON CITY ORDINANCE NO. SP-3361, S-2024

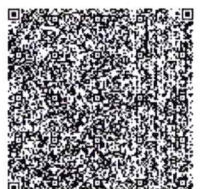
WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council recently enacted two landmark health measures: Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3285, S-2024, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Integrated Cancer Control Ordinance," and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3361, S-2024, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Cervical Cancer Elimination Ordinance";

WHEREAS, these Ordinances explicitly adopt a "Whole-of-Government" and "Whole-of-Society" approach, recognizing that the successful control and elimination of cancer requires a multi-sectoral effort that goes beyond the mandate of the health sector alone;

WHEREAS, various provisions within these Ordinances necessitate the involvement of different local government offices to effectively implement programs related to social protection, public information, human resources, gender and development, and budget accountability;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Integrated Cancer Control Ordinance, for example, mandates the coordination of the Quezon City Health Department (QCHD), the Public Affairs and Information Services Department (PAISD), the Gender and Development (GAD) Council Office, other relevant City Government departments, and barangay governments for the implementation of provisions on health promotion and health literacy;

WHEREAS, the QCHD is the lead department tasked with the implementation of these Ordinances and the drafting of their Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR);

WHEREAS, to ensure that the IRR is comprehensive, feasible, and fully compliant with the administrative and operational requirements of the City Government, it is essential that all concerned offices provide their inputs, expertise, and technical assistance during the drafting process;

WHEREAS, a unified and coordinated effort among all City departments will expedite the operationalization of these laws, thereby allowing the City Government to immediately deliver life-saving cancer services and benefits to its constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all concerned departments and offices of the Quezon City Government to actively coordinate with and extend full technical assistance to the Quezon City Health Department (QCHD) for the immediate formulation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3285, S-2024 and Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-3361, S-2024.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that these offices are encouraged to prioritize the review of the draft guidelines and provide necessary data and administrative support to the QCHD to ensure the timely release of the IRR.




