AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE UNAPPROPRIATED AMOUNT OF SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO 1. IN THE SUM OF THREE HUNDRED MILLION PESOS (PHP 300,000,000.00) TO FUND VARIOUS CITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS AND OBLIGATIONS.

Villanueva, on 13 January 2012, the Sangguniang Panlungsod approved Ordinance No. SP-2111, Series of 2012 on 30 January 2012, Supplemental Budget No. 1 in the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty One Million Pesos (PhP 751,000,000.00);

WHEREAS, the unappropriated amount is needed by the Quezon City Government to undertake and implement various approved public infrastructure and civil works investment projects;



NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. - There is hereby appropriated the amount of Three Hundred Million Pesos (PhP 300,000,000.00) by way of this Supplemental Budget No. 1 to the 2012 General Fund Budget, to finance the development programs, projects and public infrastructure programs of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 2. EXPENDITURE. - Expenditure of the amount of Three Hundred Million Pesos (PhP 300,000,000.00) in accordance with specific items of expenditures is hereby broken down as follows:

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


