A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE SPECIAL PERMIT OF TOTAL GAMEZONE XTREME, INCORPORATED TO OPERATE AN ELECTRONIC GAMES STATION LOCATED AT LOWER GROUND FLOOR CONGRESSIONAL TOWN CENTER, NO. 23 CONGRESSIONAL AVENUE, BARANGAY BAHAY TORO, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS PROMULGATED BY THE PHILIPPINE AMUSEMENT AND GAMING CORPORATION (PAGCOR)

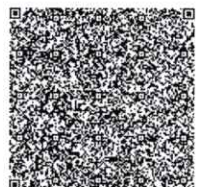

WHEREAS, Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated is a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Philippine laws located at Lower Ground Floor Congressional Town Center, No. 23 Congressional Avenue, Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the applicant was previously granted a Special Permit by the Quezon City Council for the operation of the same Electronic Games Station through Quezon City Resolution No. SP-8932, S-2022, as amended by Quezon City Resolution No. SP-9540, S-2023;

WHEREAS, to enable the applicant to continue its business operations, there is a need to renew its Special Permit pursuant to an existing City ordinance;

WHEREAS, the operation of an Electronic Games Station is regulated and licensed by the PAGCOR;

WHEREAS, Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended, and Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorize the City Council to grant or renew a Special Permit to business activities of the same nature.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to renew, as it does hereby renew, the Special Permit of Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated to operate an Electronic Games Station located at Lower Ground Floor Congressional Town Center, No. 23 Congressional Avenue, Barangay Bahay Toro, District I, Quezon City, subject to the rules and regulations promulgated by the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the authority to operate an Electronic Games (E-Games) Station granted to Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated shall be subject to the following conditions:

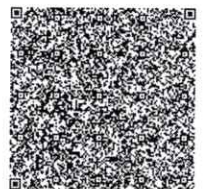
1. the holding of E-Games shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated by PAGCOR;
2. the operation of an E-Games Station shall not include playing of games not related to or other than E-Games;
3. the operation is enjoined to prohibit from playing the abovementioned games in their gaming site individuals below 21 years of age or students of any school, college, or university;
4. Total Gamezone Xtreme, Incorporated, shall remit a license fee of three percent (3%) of the gross receipt of herein grantee, which shall be made payable yearly to the City Treasurer's Office during the lifetime of this Resolution, in accordance with Section 25, Article III of Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-2773, S-2018, as amended;

5. this Resolution is non-assignable, non-transferable, and site-address specific; and
6. the establishment shall not be a nuisance to public safety and order.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this renewal of Special Permit to operate an Electronic Games Station shall be valid for a period of three (3) years from the approval of this Resolution and may be renewed again by the City Council.
